

Home Run Derby Rules:

Distance will be measured of the farthest ball hit in the air to the point at which they hit the ground.

Each sponsor pledge will give the batter 2 outs.

Balls hit in the air beyond 100 feet count as a home run and no outs are charged.

Ground balls are one out.

Swinging strikes are one out.

Foul balls do not count as an out.

The top five hitters will advance to the finals.

Finals:

Same rules as above.

Tie breakers: batters that are tied will receive 10 outs to determine a winner.

If a tie still results after the tie breaker the longest ball hit in the air will constitute the winner.
