Note: All Players must land within the Age & Grade requirements for all grades with the following exceptions:

- If a child has tested out of a grade (been moved up by the school, **must have notarized** Documentation, from the school) prior to final approval
- Pop Warner Rule (applies to leagues that have weight & age) where a child has to play up due to his weight or play in the age under for ex. 14 u, 12 u, 10u if a team has several players that are in a upper grade but play on the team during the regular season
- Must have Official league roster sent in with registration packet
- Must have league information, phone number, address, and point of contact prior to final approval
- Cannot be an All Star team (only applies to Pop Warner Teams) if you want to play down in age
- If you want an All Star team then you will play at your highest grade on your team
- This is due to the mixture of the team due to weight for example: 3 5th Graders, 15 4th Graders, 3 3rd Graders and the 5th Graders meet the age requirement for that grade as set in the Greater Wichita Junior Football League www.wichita.gov link to Parks and Rec. Jr. Football

PLAYING RULES, LENGTH OF GAME & SCORING RULES:

- We will use Kansas High School rules
- Games will consist of four (4) quarters. Each quarter will last eight (8) minutes with a ten (10) minute halftime break (time permitting)
- A touchdown is worth 6 points, an extra point (run or pass is 2 points, kick is 1 point)
- All grades will have the center protected on declared punts, field goals and extra points. Defense can't make contact with the center until such time as the ball touches the kicker, offensive player or the ground
- **We reserve the right to cut down halftime, time outs and start time in order to stay on schedule**

Check in Procedure Location to be determined

Local and Wichita Metro Teams will have the option of checking in on Thursday November 11, 2010 by appointment only 6pm to 9pm

Out of Town Teams will check In between 5:00pm to 9:00pm Friday evening November 12, 2010 (Location TBD)

The following information will assist your team in getting checked in quickly:

- Your team must line up in the exact order listed on the roster you have been given (**oldest to youngest**) and has been turned in
- You must have your copies of the player registration form in the exact same order as your roster (**no player form = player does not play**)
- You must keep players under control and reasonably quiet at all times during check in
- Players will receive a wrist band that must be worn throughout the Tournament, **if it is lost or comes off the player will not be allowed to play**, in the event that it is coming off please notify a Tournament Director or Tournament staff member at your site immediately
- We will not be able to check players in on Saturday, if a player cannot make it in, on, by, or before Friday he WILL NOT play

There will be a coaches meeting on Friday evening beginning at 8:45 to 9:30 to go over pre game check in, expectations and changes in City league rules such as:

- 2nd Grade No punting, 20 yards will be marked off and the possession of the ball is given to the opposing team.
3rd – 5th Grade: The ball will be punted. There will be NO rushing the punter or fake punts.
6th – 8th Grade: The ball will be punted. The defensive team will be allowed to rush the punter.
- Coin toss will be administer by a Tournament field supervisor 10 minutes prior to the beginning of the game
- Teams will have to be at the opposing goal post ready to take the field upon the completion of the previous game there will be no prior warning, this is it, we are attempting to stay on schedule to the best of our ability
- The Head Coach is the only one from the sideline that can speak with an official during the game.
- The Head Coach is also the only one that can request to speak with a Tournament official

Proper Conduct Policy

We have a high standard of conduct at the Air Capital Classic. Your conduct on the field, in the hotels and around the city of Wichita will ensure that your team will be welcomed back to the Air Capital Classic for many years to come.

We must clearly define what we are looking for as Proper Conduct. We will not tolerate intimidation of any form, either on or off the field. Trash talking or similar actions connected with your team will lead to penalties. Game officials are instructed to remove players from the game for 2 plays on a

FIRST TIME OFFENSE for any form of physical or verbal Intimidation and a 15 yard penalty will be marked off.

Upon a SECOND TIME OFFENSE the player will be ejected game...NO DEBATE...NO APPEALS...FINAL.

You as the Head Coach must also control your parents; they must know their actions in the stands have an effect on their football team. If there is any single incident involving the parents/fans of your team, the Air Capital Directors have the authority stop the play of the game and your team will forfeit the game.

This could cost not only the loss of a championship, but also future participation to the Air Capital Classic.

You as a Head Couch must also conduct yourself on and off the field. If you have a problem with a game official, conduct yourself properly; you wouldn't want your team to finish the tournament without you.

NOTE: The Head Coach or the Assistant Coach must be present at the Check in. Please have your players line up the same order as the roster has been prepared In (oldest to youngest).
