FOOTBALL

Remember – we except first year players at any age group.

Players are required to bring a copy of your birth certificate to the registration.

Registration fees are as follows:

\$125.00/ 1st child, \$75.00/ 2nd child, and \$50.00/ each additional child in the same family & \$60.00 for FLAG FOOTBALL.

Fundraising Fee: \$35.00 / Family (in addition to registration fees) which will be recouped once you sell 7 monthly lotto's this excludes the fresh/soph team. Players will be based on age (4-15) then weight. Parents will meet their coaches at weigh in and equipment handouts.

GAMES: Most games will be played either Friday or Saturday. Home games will be played at ANDOVER APACHES home field in Linthicum. Away games will be played within Anne Arundel county.

PRACTICE: The first week (July 21 – 25) of practice will be no equipment (shorts & Tshirt). After the first week it will be full equipment (starting July28). Practice will be 5 nights a week until school starts which then will be limited to 3 nights a week. The season will go through until late October or November depending on playoffs and championship games.

5 YEAR OLD TACKLE: Practice for 5 year old tackle will be one or two nights a week followed by a game during the week.

FLAG FOOTBALL: Practice will be a couple of nights a week followed by a game during the week.
