

# Ararat Cal Ripken Baseball League

## All Star Selection Policy

### Amount of Post Season Teams:

The board of directors shall assess the number of players in the league and determine the amount of all star teams the league shall submit for the coming post season play. At a minimum, the league shall submit a 12U and 10U team to represent the league at the District four tournaments. If the league player numbers warrant, the board may also decide to roster a second team in an age group. (12, 11) & (10, 9)

### Manager Selections:

The board of directors shall notify all of the managers and coaches of the league the intended amount of teams being rostered for the coming post season play and that they are accepting applications for All Star Managers. Each applicant shall submit to the board their coaching background and team they are interested in managing. Only current rostered league managers or coaches shall be considered.

From the qualified applicants, the board of directors shall select the manager for each all star team before the team selection process is conducted. A manager may only appear on one post season roster as either a manager or coach

### Coaching Staff Selection:

Once selected, the manager shall select his/her coaching staff from the current rostered coaches of the league. It is encouraged, but not required for the manager to select coaches from different towns within the league to promote continuity. A coach may only appear on one post season roster as either a manager or coach.

### Player Eligibility

Each rostered Cal Ripken Major or Minor player shall be eligible for All Star participation if he/she meets the minimum games played in the league and is held in good standing by his/her home association.

The board of directors shall solicit input from the League coaches to determine the eligibility of all of the players and once determined, shall convey via the head coaches or league representative an invite to try-out for their age appropriate team.

Only League 12's and 11's may tryout for the 12U team.

Only League 10's and 9 & under players may tryout for the 10U team.

Once the rosters have been finalized for the 12U and 10U team, the board shall decide if a second team at that age level is warranted. A second team could be a combination of age levels, such as a 12B team, or be a specific age level such as an 11U team.
