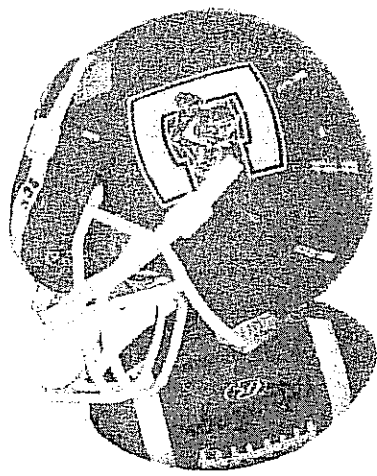

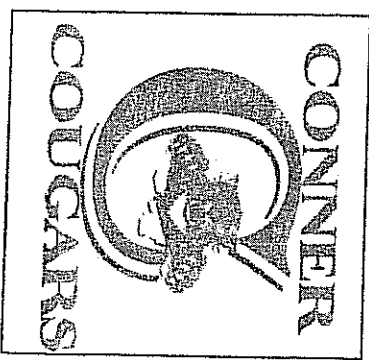

- ages 8 through 13 HS/BCPWFL 2009 Football Camp is a full contact instructional camp.

CAMP FORMAT

WHAT TO BRING

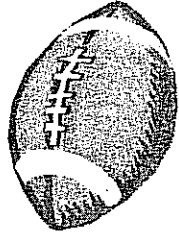
