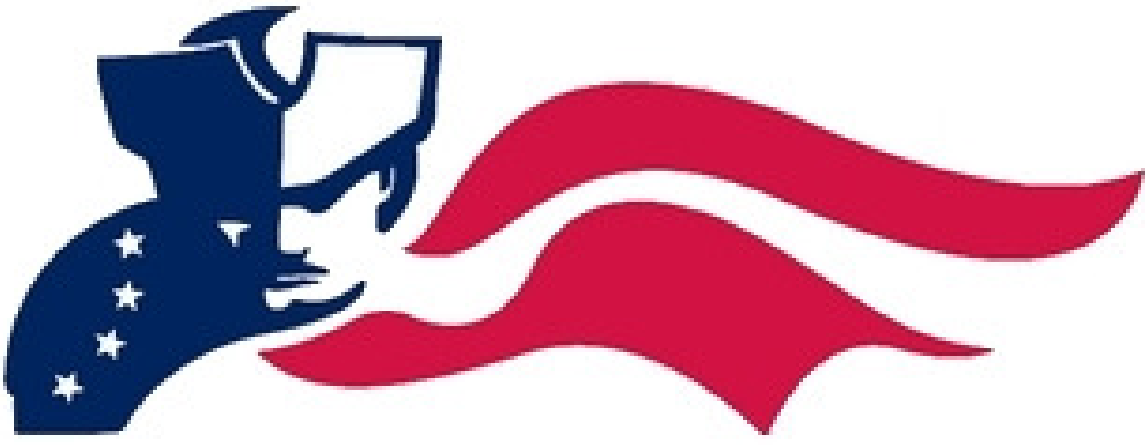

Profile of Jack D. Sweet

Jack D. Sweet was a dedicated educator for thirty years in the former Blairstown High School and later the North Warren Regional High School in Blairstown, NJ. Jack was an administrator at North Warren from 1981-1994, serving as Vice Principal and later Principal until his retirement. He was a 1954 graduate of Belvidere High School and graduated from East Stroudsburg University in 1963 with a Bachelor's Degree in Education, later attaining his Master's Degree in Education. Jack served in the Army from 1955-57. Jack is most fondly remembered for coaching powerhouse soccer teams at Blairstown High School and North Warren Regional High School from 1964-1983.

Jack was a member of the Belvidere United Methodist Church where he served on the Administrative Board. He was a member and past president of the Blairstown Rotary Club, former member of the Warren County Community College Board of Trustees, New Jersey State Interscholastic Athletic Association Executive Committee, former member of the Blairstown Elementary Board of Education, former board member of the NJSIAA, former Blairstown Township Committeeman and member of the Blairstown Democratic Club. Jack was also inducted into the New Jersey State Coaches Hall of Fame in 1985.

Jack passed away on Sunday, Sept. 26, 2004 and the Jack D. Sweet Memorial is a reminder of his life and the everlasting affect he had on the young men that passed through the North Warren Soccer Program.
