



The following document will outline several selection processes:

- Coaches
- Team assignments
- Team name assignments
- Player designation

Coaches:

Any person wishing to volunteer as a coach within the BYBSA, will be considered on the following criteria:

- 1.-Be required to complete and return a background investigation form to the Secretary of the BYBSA, regardless of the league or activity. The background investigation will be conducted by a third party company as determined by the BYBSA BoD's. The 3rd party investigation company will communicate the results to the BoD's. (The BoD's will exercise prejudice, in an effort to keep this information confidential.)
- 2.-A background investigation will be valid for 24months as of this writing.
- 3.-No coach will be allowed to participate as a coach, until item #1 has been completed, and results have been reviewed by the BoD's or its designate.
- 4.-Be in good standing with the BYBSA.
- 5.-Should a person feel that the results from a background investigation are incorrect, then that person may petition the BoD's for a special hearing. (***Please refer to the Code of Conduct, Grievance Committee section.***)

Team Assignments:

Teams (*Recreational*) will be divided as equally as numerically possible. Also, every effort will be made to equally distribute "Older League Age" players between teams.

Teams will be assigned to the Coaches of their respective sport by the following criteria, in numerical order, from lowest to highest:

- 1.-Returning Head Coach to the same league.
- 2.-Returning Head Coach, moving up from the league below.
- 3.-Returning Assistant Coach to the same league.
- 4.-Returning Assistant Coach, moving up from the league below.
- 5.-New to BYBSA Coach.

***Note:**

A) A Coach will be considered as "Returning" if they completed coaching, for the previous spring season.

B) Should there be 2 or more equally qualified persons, then the outcome shall be determined by a coin flip, the best 4 out of 7.

Team Name Assignments:

The team name assignments will follow the same criteria as above, in "Team Assignments".

Player Designation:

Any player participating in a BYBSA sanctioned League Try-Out, **will designate their intention** to be considered for a "Competition Level" team, **prior** to participating in the Try-Out. This information will be communicated to "All Coaches" in attendance. Should the player not be selected for "Competition Level", then that player will be returned to the "Recreation Level" pool, for drafting as outlined in the BYBSA Ground Rules.
