The following is to explain the specific association/league policy, rules and requirements governing acceptable and unacceptable behavior of adult and children spectators at all games throughout the Central Texas Youth Football Association.

The general policy is to protect the integrity of our children's BASTROP YOUTH FOOTBALL AND CHEERLEADING ORGANIZATION.

In order to ensure that ALL PLAYERS are protected, the parents/guardians and friends will also be accountable for his/her behavior at all league games. The parents/guardians and friends will also be accountable for the behavior and actions of their children and teenagers.

The following is to certify that the parents/guardians understand their responsibility as stated by the listed rules below. Failure to comply will result in immediate expulsion of the person breaking the rules.

PLEASE READ RULES VERY CAREFULLY.

Effective immediately:

- 1) There will not be consumption of alcoholic beverages at any time.
- 2) Cheering words of encouragement to your team player is acceptable as long as it is not done in a manner that provokes or embarrasses.
- 3) Profane language at any game is unacceptable behavior.
- 4) Harassing or "name calling" any football official, player from either team, coaches from either team, cheerleaders, etc. is **NOT ACCEPTABLE AND WILL NOT BE TOLERATED BY THE LEAGUE AND IT'S OFFICIALS** as well as by the corresponding host youth associations (Optimist Club, Youth Association, parent organization, etc.)
- 5) Cooperation with the team players representative or official team representative on duty at the games is expected of very parent/guardian.
- 6) The parent/guardian will support the rules and decisions of the coaches. As parents/guardians one realizes that this is a game for children and **NOT** professional athletes.
- 7) If the opposing team's adult spectators are breaking rules, it does not mean that you are entitled to break the rules. To follow suit is unacceptable behavior.
- 8) Parents/guardians, and any spectator will exhibit and support sportsmanship at all times to the best of their ability.

This document **MUST** be read and signed by the participant's parent/guardians **BEFORE** the participant is allowed to take part in any league game.
