Meeting Summary for May 7, 2006

Meeting Summary:

The Churchville-Chili Lacrosse Club (to be abbreviated as "the Club") was held at the Scottsville Ice Arena and was called to order by Steve Grogan at 5:05. Thank you to the Gorino's for allowing us to meet there. It worked out great.

The Club by-laws were reviewed and voted on and unanimously approved.

The meeting minutes for the January 26, 2006 meeting were voted on and were unanimously approved with no corrections.

Summer League Opportunities

Todd Yunker would like to have Modified (current 6th & 7th graders) in the Rush-Henrietta league – if space becomes available. Otherwise, we would sign up for the TSE indoor league on Wednesday nights. JV & Varsity would be in the TSE league, since there aren't any other viable options. JV will be current 8th and 9th graders (or by recommendation of the school or club coaches and depending on space available) and would play on Thursday nights. Varsity will be current 10 & 11th graders (or by recommendation of the school or club coaches and depending on space available) and would play on Monday nights.

Sign up will begin as soon as possible (watch the website) and fall/winter Club players will be given first chance to register. Watch the website for more information: www.c-clacrosse.com It will then be opened up to others. Each summer league team will have a maximum of 20 players. The modified team will be first come, first served. The JV and Varsity teams will have tryouts, should we get a large turnout. The coaches will assess skill level during a short tryout period.

Tournaments

Todd Yunker, Coaches Coordinator reported the following: Sackets Harbor 1812 Shootout tournament will be held July 8 and 9. We would like to have a Modified, JV & Varsity team for the tournament.

Tournament teams will be by invitation of the coaches. Selection will be based on skill level for sake of safety. Other tournaments are the Webster Classic held on June 24 and R-H LAX Festival held on June 25. More information will be announced as it becomes available.

Coaching

Last year's coaches will be back (Jeff Mee (V), Len Hemink (JV) and Todd Yunker (M)), but we could really use more coaches. If you are interested, please let Todd Yunker know. If we have a large turnout, especially at the modified level, we could add another team – if we had more coaches.

US Lacrosse membership

Your child MUST register for US Lacrosse in order to play for the Club. Membership is good for one year, includes the US Lacrosse magazine, but most importantly provides insurance that will cover your son at practice, games and tournaments. Renee Yunker will keep track of this for the Club.

Treasurer's Report

Jean Mee reported that we have \$2,122.40 in our account.

The Club will pay for the registration fee for Summer leagues and tournament fees (the down payment). The rest of the fee will be divided equally amongst the boys playing on the teams.

Steve Grogan proposed that the Club pay for up to five (5) US Lacrosse memberships for the coaching staff. It was unanimously approved. Coaches should purchase their membership and submit receipts for reimbursement.

We discussed if board members would need US Lacrosse memberships to be on the safe side. Sal Gorino offered to look into Board insurance since it would cover general liability and might be cheaper for the Club.

Fund Raising

The following ideas were suggested: Lottery (once summer league teams are formed, or wait until fall league), t-shirts, Avon, cookie dough, candles, wine tasting, and car wash.

It was suggested that we continue to represent the Club in a respectful way and be sure to keep our fundraising to a minimum so that we don't raise flags with the school personnel.

New Team Jerseys/Pinnies

We would like to have reversible, numbered jerseys that have the Club name on it. Gino Marcello graciously offered to buy them for the teams.
