Meeting Summary:

The Churchville-Chili Lacrosse was held at the Scottsville Ice Arena and was called to order by Steve Grogan at 6:00 PM

The minutes for the May 7, 2006 meeting were voted on and unanimously approved.

Jean Mee, Club Treasurer, reported that the Lacrosse Club account has a current balance of \$2,922.46. Much of the money in the account will be used to pay for tournaments and leagues.

The fall lacrosse newsletter was the agenda for our meeting. Steve Grogan went through each section.

Fundraising: The lottery fundraiser was discussed. Tickets were available for pick up at the meeting and are due back on October 15. Selling all 20 tickets will give you a \$25 credit toward the winter league. If a player is asked to play for more than one team (ex: JV and Varsity) you can earn \$25 towards each level of play.

New business:

Adding grades 3&4, 5&6 to the Club: All members present voted on and approved adding the younger kids to the Club. Effective immediately, John Buck will give the Treasurer all the funds collected so far, and Jean will pay out the league fees to TSE. The Club will not contribute \$100 toward the league fee until the younger players' families have had the chance to help in the fundraising efforts. The officers will see to it that they have the help needed to successfully fundraise.

RIT's lacrosse coach, Gene Peluso, has offered to come to talk to parents of the JV and Varsity players about the college lacrosse recruiting process. A meeting announcement will follow.

Todd Yunker, Coaches Coordinator, announced the results of Summer 2006 leagues and tournaments.

- 7/8 played at Sackets Harbor on July 8 and placed 7th out of 32 teams
- Varsity played at the TSE Blaze tournament on July 22 and finished up 2 and 2 against stiff competition
- JV had a scrimmage at Fairport and did well (their tournament was canceled due to poor field conditions)
- 7/8 played a summer league at TSE and had a 6-0 record. Way to go!
- We held clinics at Sanford Road Park in July and had a good turnout each week.
