

Crooked Crosse Lacrosse Club Scholarship Program

Crooked Crosse Lacrosse Club (CCLC) encourages providing the opportunity for all youth to participate and enjoy playing the game of boy's lacrosse. To that end, limited scholarship funds are available to cover the full or partial costs associated with playing lacrosse with CCLC. In addition to basic registration fees, approved scholarship funding may also provide for the equipment needed to participate in CCLC sponsored activities. Scholarship applications are available on our web site under Forms and Handouts. *All applications will remain confidential.*

Requirements and Guidelines:

1. Family/player must reside in Upper Dublin Township. Proof of residency may be required.
2. All information in the scholarship application is confidential and will not be released without the express written authorization of the applicant.
3. For multiple family participants, an application must be completed for each proposed scholarship applicant.
4. Once a scholarship recipient is registered for a program, participation in the full program session is required. Withdrawal from the program for any unexcused reason will result in scholarship ineligibility for one (1) year. This will require a commitment to attend a minimum of 80% of scheduled practices and games. Transportation is not provided by CCLC.
5. All scholarship applications will be reviewed within ten (10) days of CCLC receiving a completed application. Applicants will be notified of approval or denial in a timely fashion.
 - If a partial-scholarship is granted, the remaining fees and registration information must be received within ten (10) days of notification or the scholarship offer will be voided.
 - If a full-scholarship is granted, all registration information must be received within ten (10) days of notification or the scholarship offer will be voided.
6. Scholarship funds are only for boys in grades 1-8
7. **Funding is limited.** If funds are available and the application is approved, each participant may register for up to two (2) programs per year. CCLC reserves the right to limit the number of scholarships based on funds available.
8. Scholarships will be reviewed and awarded to only those applicants who file completed applications before the advertised registration deadline for the program session.
9. All equipment issued as part of a scholarship award must be returned promptly upon the end of the program session. If the scholar fails to return such equipment, scholar will be prohibited from participating in CCLC activities until the equipment is returned in good order.
10. Incomplete applications will not be considered
