

# 2009 JUNIOR DIVISION – LOCAL RULES

*Based upon Local Rules on file with Western Region Little League Headquarters  
San Bernardino, California*



The following modifications of Little League Baseball Official Regulations and Playing Rules, Minor League Divisions, have been adopted as “Local Rules” for the Junior Division of Claremont American Little League:

1. Play is governed by the Little League Green Book.
2. Teams will bat the line up.
3. Game time will be two hours and thirty minutes (2:30) with no new inning after that time. Drop dead time will be at two hours and forty-five minutes (2:45).
4. Mercy rule: 10 runs or more after 5 innings.
5. Ground rules: Any fly ball hitting the large tree in left field or hitting/landing over the sidewalk north of the tree is a home run. Any ground ball hitting the large tree in left field or hitting/landing over the sidewalk north of the tree is a ground rule double. All other batted balls hit in the rest of the outfields are “all you can get”.
6. Pitch count: both teams keep track and verify after each inning and sign the appropriate sheets after the games are concluded.
