2009 Registration Information Attachment

Conference: The Claremont Wolfpack Jr. All American Football & Cheer (“CJAAFC”) is a member of the San Gabriel Valley Junior All American Conference, Inc. (“Conference”), and the CJAAFC is required to abide by the rules and regulations as defined by the Conference organization.

I have read and understand this section, please initial here: _____

Certification Day: Certification Day for the 2009 football and cheer season has been set for **Saturday, August 22nd, 2009**. The location and attendance time will be announced after the season begins. On Certification Day, all potential participants’ information, including academic records is reviewed. On Certification Day, all teams are assembled and the potential participants are officially weighed. If your child weight falls within the designated age and weight guidelines and all of his/her paperwork is in order, your child will be “certified” by Conference to participate during the season. Following Certification Day only those participants who have been “certified” by Conference may continue to practice with their respective teams. ***It is understood that attendance at Certification Day is critical.*** If, for whatever reason your child does not attend Certification Day, or fails to certify, he or she will not be eligible to participate in any program activities. If your child fails to attend Certification Day, then fails to attend the “make-up” Certification Day and / or fails to meet Conference age / weight requirements, you may be entitled to a partial refund, please review the “CJAAFC Refund Policy” for refund information.

Cuts: It is understood that all CJAAFC tackle teams are limited to 33 players on the final team roster as of Certification Day. It is also understood that each football team may recruit up to a total of 40 players for the start of the football season. Be advised there is a possibility of that player cuts will have to be conducted in order for a football squad to reduce and reach it’s mandatory team roster size prior to Certification Day and that your son / daughter may, as a result, be cut from the team. It is understood that the decision to cut any player is at the discretion of the team’s coaching staff and CJAAFC Board. Football skill is NOT a determining factor for cuts. ***The following factors are considered critical in determining cuts:*** 1) attendance at all practice sessions; 2) safety issues; 3) attitude and respect toward the coaching staff and other players; and 4) following CJAAFC instructions. If your child is cut, you may be entitled to a partial refund, please review the “CJAAFC Refund Policy” for refund information.

Safety Concerns: Youth football is often the first opportunity for children to participate in contact sports. It is normal, particularly with younger players, for children to display some initial reluctance about contact. The CJAAFC coaching staff has been advised, however to be sensitive towards these players who display a continued reluctance to participate in tackling and other contact drills as these children could be more prone to injury. Further, the coaches realize that a player who does not enjoy contact will not enjoy his/her football experience and will be less likely to play football again. It is understood that if your child displays these characteristics, a coach will make a reasonable attempt to discuss this matter with the child and parent/guardian. It is understood that if the child continues to display a reluctance to participate in contact drills and the coaching staff makes the determination that a safety concern is present; this child will be asked to withdraw from the program for safety reasons. If the parent/guardian refuses to withdraw the child, he/she will be cut from the program by the coaching staff and CJAAFC Board. If your child drops or is cut due to safety concerns, you may be entitled to a partial refund, please review the “CJAAFC Refund Policy” for refund information.

Grades: It is required by Conference that all players/cheerleaders maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA throughout the school year. Grades are checked at the beginning of each season and again during the month of October. Conference may also randomly check grades throughout the season. It is agreed that all families will assist Conference and the CJAAFC with academic documentation and will not withhold academic information from the two entities. It is also agreed not to alter or in anyway attempt to deceive Conference or the CJAAFC as to a child’s academic record information. The assistance in obtaining any and all necessary information from the child’s school is required to comply with the academic records request. It’s been advised that academic falsifications or Alterations will result in the child’s immediate dismissal from the CJAAFC program and could also result in his/her being banned from participating with any team within Conference for the following season. It’s additionally advised that academic falsifications or alterations could result in severe sanctions against the team in which the child participates. If, at anytime, a child’s grades fall below the required 2.0 GPA, or a parent /guardian refuses to allow Conference or the CJAAFC access to academic information, it is understood that the child will be ineligible to continue to participate with the program. If your child is cut due to academic ineligibility, you may be entitled to a partial refund, please review the “CJAAFC Refund Policy” for refund information.

Age and Weight: It is understood that a player's placement on a team is based on a combination of age (age attained as of 12/31/09) and weight. As part of this application a parent/guardian has the opportunity to review the latest age / weight "eligibility information" as instituted by the Conference and available on the Conference website. It is further understood that CJA AFC has no control over the "eligibility information" requirements. It is understood that these requirements may not be waived or altered regardless of any extenuating circumstances. It is understood that it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to enroll their child in the appropriate division based on age and weight combination.

Movement of Players between weight divisions: During the first day of practice, if the CJA AFC determines that a child is more than 10 lbs. above or 5 lbs. below the designated weight requirements in the division which the child was enrolled, the CJA AFC has the authority to relocate a child to another division within the CJA AFC organization. It is understood that the CJA AFC may relocate a child only if there is additional room on another CJA AFC squad. If at the time this determination is made and a parent/guardian refuses to offer their consent to move the child to another team, it is understood that a child will not be permitted to further participate within the CJA AFC organization. If the parent refuses to relocate their child to a different team within the CJA AFC program due to weight requirements, you may be entitled to a partial refund, please review the "CJA AFC Refund Policy" for refund information.

Registration Fee: It is understood that the entire amount of registration fee is due and owing at the time this application is submitted. However, it is understood that if a parent / guardian elects to participate with the CJA AFC "Payment Installment Plan" the CJA AFC will hold the child's position on the division roster as long as the remaining payments are paid as agreed, please review your "Payment Plan" application for scheduled payments, due dates and disclaimers.

Geographical Locations: It is understood that Conference rules require that all players on the CJA AFC Wolfpack reside within the CJA AFC recruiting area (Claremont) or an "open" city. It is understood that if a child resides in an area that falls outside the specified areas, the child will need special permission from Conference to play for the CJA AFC program. If the permission is not granted, it is understood that the child will not be permitted to participate with the CJA AFC.

Vacations: It is understood that family vacations / functions may conflict with the practice schedule. Attendance at practice is of paramount importance and that a failure to attend practice(s) could be a significant factor in a Coach's decision to cut a player.

CJA AFC Refund Policy: If a child voluntarily withdraws from the CJA AFC program for any other reason prior to the start of the season, the parent / guardian is entitled to a full registration refund less shirts & spirit pack costs. If a child is injured and cannot physically continue to participate with the CJA AFC program prior to Certification Day, the parent / guardian is entitled to a registration refund less a 20% administration fee plus equipment reconditioning fees and shirts & spirit pack costs. If a child is cut for reasons identified in the "Cuts" section from a football team or is removed due to safety concerns as identified in the "Safety Concerns" section prior to Certification Day, the parent / guardian is entitled to a registration refund less a 30% administration fee plus equipment reconditioning fees and shirts & spirit pack costs. If a child voluntarily withdraws from the CJA AFC program for any other reason, including, but not limited to, a failure to maintain the required minimum 2.0 GPA prior to Certification Day, the parent / guardian is entitled to a registration refund less a 40% administration fee plus equipment reconditioning fees and shirts & spirit pack costs. If a child is injured after Certification Day and is not capable of continuing with the CJA AFC program, the parent / guardian will be entitled to a registration refund less a 40% administration fee plus equipment reconditioning fees and shirts & spirit pack costs. If a child is removed from the CJA AFC program after Certification Day for any reason (except validated injury), including but not limited to: failure to satisfy academic requirements, failure to satisfy weight requirements, player code of conduct violations, decides to quit the team, player attendance, parent code of conduct violations, geographical falsification, the parent / guardian will be entitled to a registration refund less a 60% administration fee plus equipment reconditioning fees and shirts & spirit pack costs.
