## GENERAL

Welcome to Crofton Cheerleading's youth-recreational program! The cheerleading program runs from August through April/May. The fall season begins in August and runs through November. The winter cheer season starts in December and runs through May.

*DEFINITION OF A CHEERLEADER:* A cheerleader serves to boost team spirit, promote good sportsmanship, and develop good positive crowd involvement. Cheerleaders are athletes. Thus, they must condition, practice and warm-up the same as other athletes in preparation for a performance and they are susceptible to accidents and injuries as any other athlete may be.

## TEAM DIVISIONS

Teams are divided by age. Per Anne Arundel County rules: age is determined as of 9/1  
In general, Divisions are usually made following the guidelines below:

Tiny's: 6 & under  
Mini's: 6-8 yr olds  
Juniors: 8-10 yr olds  
Seniors: 10-14 yr olds

## PRACTICES

Each team practices approximately twice per week, in the evenings after 6pm, for 60 – 90 minutes. There may be an occasion that a team will practice 3 times during a week – usually the week before competition. Practices are mandatory & necessary to learn the cheers and routines. If you do not attend practice, you may not be allowed to attend competition. You must inform your coach of any scheduling conflicts or if you become sick and are unable to attend a practice.

**Practice schedules** will be announced once registration is closed. A coach or the commissioner will contact you with practice days, times and locations. In addition, each coach will hold a team meeting with parents to discuss the upcoming season and schedules.

## PRACTICE POLICY

Due to the spacing available and our agreement with facilities personnel, last year we instituted a new policy for indoor space use. Please note our policy regarding practices: ***Parent, siblings and friends are NOT allowed to attend practice unless they are serving as a volunteer (e.g., chaperone, asst coach). Because coaches are volunteers, coach's children (that do not cheer) may be present. The designated chaperone will assist with 'watching' these 'extra' children.***

Note, to avoid the 'transition' to this, coaches may implement this policy for outside practices as well. Please support the program and your coach by following this policy. If you have a problem or concern regarding this policy, please discuss this with your coach or with me. Certain facilities have only agreed to allow us use of their space – only if we follow this policy.

**CHAPERONE POLICY:** The CAC has a chaperone policy for sports that use the indoor facilities (i.e., schools). This policy required an adult, besides the coach, to be present at practices held inside. This is to monitor use of the facility and to ensure proper care is taken. Often team moms or a parent will volunteer to perform this duty. The Team Parent will be in-charge of scheduling a chaperone-duty list, if needed.

Guidelines for use of schools will be distributed when we begin using the schools. Please be sure to follow & respect them.

## FOOTBALL GAMES:

There will be approximately 9 football games (5 home games and 4 away games) plus playoff and championship games that teams must cheer at. Cheerleaders are expected to arrive at all games 15 minutes early in uniform. County guidelines require that any cheerleader participating in competition cheer must attend all scheduled games. **If a cheerleader does not attend all scheduled games they may not be able to compete in competition(s).**

## PLAYER CONTRACTS:

Cheerleading is an Anne Arundel County recognized sport and as such requires that every player signs a contract to respect the sport, coaches and teammates.

## OPTIONAL CHEERLEADING GYMNASTICS

Enrolling in extra tumbling classes is highly recommended. If you are interested in obtaining additional information, please see a coach or team mom at practice. Please feel free to talk to your coach or team mom about tumbling.

Tumbling will be incorporated into team practices; however separate instruction for (at least) an hour a week is much more beneficial for building tumbling skills.

## COMPETITIONS

Competitions are optional. A commitment and non-refundable competition fee will be required at the beginning of each season. If you would like your cheerleader to participate in competitions, they must participate in **ALL**. In order to participate in competitions you **must** cheer for a sport (football in the fall/basketball in the winter). Please note the deadline for turning the forms and money in...this is necessary for the coaches to prepare the routine and to make sure the team is ready! All forms and competition fees of \$120 are due by September 3.

## INDIVIDUAL COMPETING OPTIONS

There are opportunities throughout the year for those interested in competing as an individual. Often competitions we attend will hold a jump-off or tumble-off competition. At some limited competitions, there are opportunities for small stunt groups and individuals to perform a short (approx 1 minute) routine and compete. If your daughter is interested in an individual routine and/or partner stunt group, jump or tumble off, please inform your coach or the commissioner immediately.

## UNIFORMS

A uniform deposit of \$200 – check payable to CAC and post-dated for November 30 – must be received prior to distribution of uniform items. Each girl will receive a skirt, vest, and unifit (turtleneck) that must be kept and returned in good condition. Sizing of uniforms will be done at one of the first practices, so please be sure to attend all practices in order to have your daughter properly sized. IF the uniform items are returned in good condition, your uniform deposit check will NOT be cashed. Each cheerleader is also required to have cheer shoes (approx. \$45-50). Cheerleaders must have black bloomers, socks and bows. All will be provided and are included in your registration. You may submit an order for any additional items to your coach/team mom at practice, etc. Please provide size information for bloomers to your coach as well.
