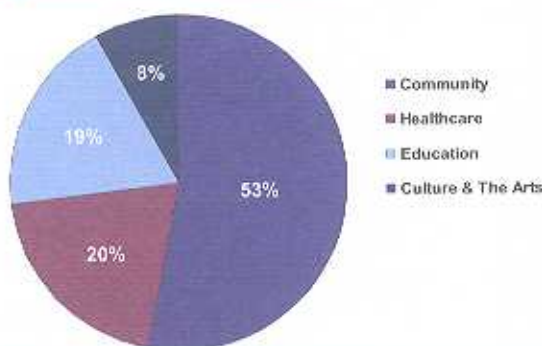

Commerce Bank is dedicated to its role as a caring corporate citizen. We offer a broad array of programs, from special youth and nonprofit-focused initiatives to educational and volunteer opportunities. Since opening in 1973, Commerce has contributed over \$55 million to nonprofit organizations that enrich the quality of life within our neighborhoods.

Essential support is provided through a wide range of community outreach initiatives:

- **Coins for Caring** uses Commerce's Penny Arcade coin-counting machines to raise dollars for disaster relief and special charitable activities. In 2005, Coins for Caring raised \$714,000 for the American Red Cross' Tsunami and Hurricane Katrina campaigns through customer donations and Commerce matching funds.
- **Commerce WOW!Zone** is a free, nationally-accredited financial literacy program for grades K-12 – both in-school and online. Through this interactive program, children learn money management skills they can use for the rest of their lives. In 2005, 600 trained instructors volunteered over 5,000 hours of classroom and in-store instruction to 4,900 classes. In the last 16 years, we've taught over 300,000 students!
- Our **Summer Reading Program** encourages kids in grades K-12 to keep their reading skills sharp during summer vacation and helps them earn money – Commerce deposits \$10 into a savings account for each child who reads 10 books.
- **Executive Reading Week** kicks off our Summer Reading Program each May. Bank executives read books on the importance of saving money to elementary school students throughout the communities we serve, then donate the books to the schools' libraries.
- **Commerce Bank's American Dream Scholarships** award \$1,000 scholarships to graduating high school seniors within our footprint who have demonstrated academic achievement and a commitment to community service.
