CODE OF CONDUCT
GUIDELINES FOR ALL ATHLETIC PROGRAMS

The Carver Athletic programs trademark has always been based on team values and good sportsmanship. As we remain competitive in nature we project these qualities to our opponents, our players and the community. This program should encourage both the development of positive self-esteem and an atmosphere among teams where mutual respect, honor and integrity are valued.

The CYBL is a voluntary program designed to meet the needs and interest of the children in grades 1 through 8 who want to participate in basketball as a team sport. Some of the qualities an athlete should possess are: dedication to the sport in which he/she participates, a willingness to make sacrifices for the team, a desire to improve himself/herself on or off the court.

ACCIDENT REPORTS AND INSURANCE GUIDELINES

The following procedures will be followed in case of injury. All injuries are to be reported to the coach. The coach and player will fill out an accident report, which will be sent to the respective commissioner.

RULES OF PARTICIPATION

CYBL Athletes must remember that participation in the Carver Athletic program is a privilege that can be revoked at any time.

MEDICAL EXCUSE: CYBL Athletes must have clearance from their family physician to play basketball. Any exceptions or issues must be communicated to a board member in writing at registration.

UNEXCUSED ABSENCES FROM PRACTICES AND GAMES: A player or parent should make every effort to notify the coach of any practice or game that he/she may miss. It is up to the coach's discretion as to whether excessive absences will result in limited or no playing time. Coaches will have to make the commissioners of their respective league aware of any instances before limiting an athlete's playing time below the league minimum.

SPORTSMANSHIP: Criticizing or disrespecting official, coaches, teammates, or opponents will not be tolerated. Any acts of misconduct by ANYONE will be addressed and dealt with swiftly. The CYBL is a family friendly environment and behavior unbecoming of the league will not be tolerated as to preserve a positive experience for everyone involved.

INSUBORDINATION: Any athlete who when under a coaches supervision uses profanity, is disrespectful, or displays anger that draw attention away from the game will not be tolerated.
