FNYB TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

THERE IS NO SMOKING OR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED ON ANY OF THE FIELDS. THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED AT ALL TIMES BY ALL FNYB BOARD MEMBERS!

- 1) A maximum of three (3) adult coaches are allowed on the field of play during game time while on defense.
- 2) Two (2) adult base coaches are allowed on the field while on offense.
- 3) A coin toss will determine the home team. Team traveling from the farthest location will call.
- 4) Line-ups are due 15 minutes before the scheduled start time of your game so the scorekeeper can get his/her book ready. Line-up sheets are available in the score booth.
- 5) The scorekeeper for the home team will sit IN THE SCORE BOOTH and maintain the OFFICIAL SCOREBOOK. They are responsible for logging in the pitching record of the teams and having the manager sign the log at the end of the game. The manager will carry one with him/her as they may be playing at different fields. The other copy will stay in the pitching record book.
- 6) Once you have OFFICIALLY checked in, you will be asked to carry birth certificates, medical release forms and a roster at all times during game time. One roster is to be given to the official who checks you in, to keep in the tournament folder. For those of you traveling to different fields it will be necessary to have an extra copy for the other field.
- 7) TIE BREAKER: Head to Head, Runs Allowed, Runs Scored, and Coin Toss.
- 8) Only the MANAGER will be allowed to question an umpire's call. Coaches are to stay out of it and once the decision has been made, the issue is to be put to rest and the game continued. Parents and visitors WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE FIELD hand in the judgment of the umpires.
- 9) All equipment and trash should be removed from the dugout immediately following the end of the game to allow the next team to set up and get their game underway.

10) NO ICE CHEST/COOLER:

WE HAVE PROVIDED CUPS AND WATER IN ALL DUGOUTS FOR THE PLAYERS. **Please remember that COOLERS AND/OR ICE CHESTS ARE NOT ALLOWED on our fields. WE offer a full snack bar at all fields.**

There are also plenty of fast food and dine-in restaurants in the area. In addition there are many parks close by which have BBQ's and benches if desired.
