

# **Minutes of the Glendora High School Pep Boosters**

## **August 3, 2009**

### **Welcome & Introductions – Denise Brown**

- Meeting began at 6:45 pm

### **Secretary & Correspondence Report – Joanne O'Connell & Elise Langdon**

- Minutes from July 6<sup>th</sup> meeting taken by Elise Langdon were approved by Diane and Chris Overton.
- The sign-in sheet was routed.
- Elise was asked to write a thank you note and send a gift card to the dry cleaner who helped with the cleaning of our run-through sign.
- Elise will be scheduling a meeting with the captains for website instructions.

### **Treasurer & Auditor Report – Alex Tescher , Dineen Hull & Cynthia Villa**

- The June and July Profit and Loss statements have been recorded.
- The budget will be reported in September.

### **Ways & Means Report – Patty Hurt & Terry Vukovich**

- Town-oply: Patty reported that this game should profit over \$15,000. Games should cost \$30.00 each. She needs parents to go out with groups of girls to sell spaces. The game will be in color. Pictures will be done with Pam's help. We need to start working on it right away. Anyone can call or e-mail Patty about it.
- Official Pep Club necklaces are available for \$65.85. Orders are due by August 11<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m.
- Scrip has been set-up. The boosters buy the gift cards and get a percent of it back when it is sold. There will be a three week lag time from when someone orders a gift card to when it is available.
- Wreath Sales will begin October 1<sup>st</sup> through November 30<sup>th</sup>. Pre-orders are recommended. This is a mandatory fundraiser. Details will come next month.
- Irwindale Speedway: We made \$500.00 at Irwindale Speedway. It was song/flag night. We keep coming up short so parents will be working the registers and the girls will do the running. Everyone needs to wear the uniforms. Adults cannot drink alcohol. Varsity cheer and Mascots have Labor Day weekend. The date for Flags/Song has been changed to

- October 24<sup>th</sup>. If someone is not going to be there they need to give 48 hours notice to Patty Hurt or Terry Vukovich. There will be a \$100 charge for no shows. A list of “no shows” has been given to Ms. Deal and Alex Tescher so the \$100 fee can be added to the appropriate accounts.
