

## First Team Offense

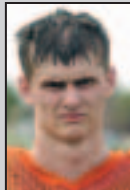


**Cam Kinley**  
Larkin, Senior, QB, 6-3, 170

Kinley's record-breaking season earned him 2007 Courier News Player of the Year honors. The two-time All-Upstate Eight Conference honoree was named the league's Offensive MVP after completing 174 of 278 passes for 2,894 yards and 34 touchdowns. This marks Kinley's second appearance on the All-Area team.

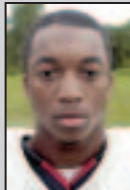
**Wes Allen**  
St. Charles East, Junior, RB, 6-1, 170

Allen returns to the All-Area team for the second straight season. The All-Upstate Eight Conference honoree was the area's second leading rusher with 1,453 yards on 224 carries. He also scored 17 touchdowns as the Saints earned a share of the UEC title.



**Darius Bowers**  
Jacobs, Senior, RB, 5-9, 173

Bowers was the driving force behind the Golden Eagles' powerful ground attack. The All-Fox Valley Conference honoree tallied 1,186 rushing yards on 156 carries, which was good for a 7.6 yard-per-carry average. He also scored 15 total touchdowns and had a team-best 221 receiving yards on 11 catches.



**Vinnie Libreri**  
Bartlett, Senior, RB, 5-9, 175

Libreri finished as the area's leading rusher with 1,368 yards on 210 carries, which was good for an average of 6.5 yards per carry. The All-Upstate Eight Conference honoree also scored 15 touchdowns while helping the Hawks reach the playoffs for the eighth straight season.



**Nick Bee**  
Larkin, Senior, WR, 5-10, 155

Bee paced Larkin's talented receiver corps, breaking a school record with his 1,076 receiving yards. The All-Upstate Eight Conference honoree finished with 50 receptions and averaged a staggering 21.5 yards per catch. Bee, the area's leading receiver, also had an area-best 13 touchdown receptions.



**Matt Hammer**  
St. Charles East, Senior, WR, 6-0, 180

Hammer finished the year with an area-best 63 receptions. The All-Upstate Eight Conference honoree was the area's third leading receiver with 808 yards. Hammer also had seven touchdown catches as he helped lead the Saints to the playoffs for the third straight year.



**Ryan Shriver**  
Larkin, Senior, WR, 5-10, 155

Shriver thrived in the Royals' spread attack. He was the area's second-leading receiver with 57 receptions for 891 yards and nine touchdowns. Shriver earned All-Upstate Eight Conference honors for his role in an offense that averaged 35.6 points per game.



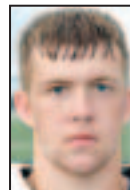
**Pat Bauers**  
Bartlett, Senior, OL, 6-0, 240

Bauers was a force at left guard, paving the way for an effective ground attack that amassed 220.2 rushing yards per game and 5.4 yards per carry. The All-Upstate Eight Conference honoree also helped the Hawks score a league-best 326 points and tally 3,551 total yards.



**Michael Dander**  
Genoa-Kingston, Senior, OL, 6-0, 200

Dander was a main catalyst for the Cogs' prolific offensive attack as the team's center. The unanimous All-Big Northern Conference West Division selection helped G-K tally 270 rushing yards per game, 6.9 yards per carry and an area-best 35.7 points per game.



**Brad Foote**  
Jacobs, Senior, OL, 6-2, 256

In his third year as a varsity starter, Foote was a major force along the Golden Eagles' offensive line as the team's center. The All-Fox Valley Conference honoree was instrumental in helping Jacobs gain 284.1 rushing yards per game and 6.1 yards per carry.



**Alex Putz**  
St. Charles East, Senior, OL, 5-11, 245

Putz was the leader along the Saints' offensive line as the unit's only returning starter. The left guard garnered All-Upstate Eight Conference honors while helping pace an offense that averaged 297.8 yards per game and 5.1 yards per rushing attempt.



**Matt VanAcker**  
Burlington Central, Senior, OL, 6-1, 225

VanAcker played a key role in the Rockets' option ground attack, helping Central average 24.2 points per game and reach the playoffs for the seventh time in eight years. The two-year starter was a unanimous All-Big Northern Conference East Division selection.



**T.J. Burzak**  
Hampshire, Senior, TE, 6-4, 200

Burzak's size and athletic ability made him a major offensive force as he hauled in 29 passes for 574 yards and 17 touchdowns in his third varsity season. The unanimous All-Big Northern Conference East Division honoree also contributed on defense, tallying 42 tackles, 40 assisted tackles and two interceptions as a linebacker.

## First Team Defense

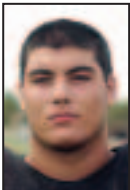


**Tim Janeway**  
St. Charles North, Senior, DL, 6-0, 195

Janeway anchored a defensive line that helped hold opponents to 19.7 points per game, the third lowest total in the area. The All-Upstate Eight Conference honoree posted impressive numbers, racking up 44 total tackles and team-bests in sacks (12.5), tackles for a loss (17) and fumble recoveries (5).

**Dave Mashal**  
St. Charles East, Senior, DL, 6-2, 265

Mashal lived up to his reputation as one of the area's top defensive tackles, consistently drawing double teams from opponents. The All-Upstate Eight Conference honoree finished second in voting for the league's defensive MVP. Mashal finished with 35 tackles, nine tackles for a loss and one interception.



**K.C. McCarty**  
Genoa-Kingston, Senior, DL, 6-3, 200

McCarty was a key two-way player who earned unanimous All-Big Northern Conference West Division honors. His biggest contributions came on defense, where he recorded 43 tackles, 22 assisted tackles and six tackles for a loss. On offense, McCarty tallied 15 catches for 223 yards and two touchdowns as a tight end.



**Jordan Romano**  
Burlington Central, Senior, DL, 6-4, 270

Romano played a key role in helping the Rockets hold opponents to 18 points per game, the second lowest total in the area. He earned unanimous All-Big Northern Conference East Division honors as Central recorded at least seven wins for the fourth time in five years.



**Kevin Billington**  
Genoa-Kingston, Senior, LB, 6-0, 205

Billington's 59 tackles and five tackles for a loss were important, but the unanimous All-Big Northern Conference West Division honoree's biggest impact came on offense. As a running back, Billington racked up 1,186 yards on 183 carries and had an area-best 21 touchdowns.



**Pat Friel**  
St. Charles East, Senior, LB, 6-2, 205

Friel stood out among the Saints' talented corps of linebackers that helped East hold opponents to an area-low 12.9 points per game. The All-Upstate Eight Conference honoree led the team with 83 tackles, 12 tackles for a loss and 2½ sacks.



**Moises Quiroga**  
St. Edward, Junior, LB, 5-11, 200

Quiroga was once again a major force on both sides of the ball for the Green Wave. The All-Suburban Catholic Conference selection recorded a team-best 75 tackles to go along with two sacks. Quiroga was also St. Edward's leading rusher, gaining 602 yards and seven touchdowns on 126 carries.



**Kyle Zelinsky**  
Bartlett, Junior, LB, 6-2, 225

The All-Upstate Eight Conference honoree led the Hawks with 76 tackles, 23 assisted tackles and 11 tackles behind the line of scrimmage while helping lead a defense that held opponents to only 112.8 rushing yards per game.



**Dan Hagberg**  
Burlington Central, Senior, DB, 6-1, 175

Hagberg excelled on both sides of the field. The unanimous All-Big Northern Conference honoree totaled 1,123 rushing yards and 13 TDs on 139 carries while guiding Central's option attack.



**Mike Lefelstein**  
St. Charles North, Junior, DB, 5-9, 155

The All-Upstate Eight Conference honoree made 24 tackles, assisted on 10 tackles and recovered two fumbles. Lefelstein also tied for the team lead in interceptions with four.



**Trace Teboda**  
Hampshire, Senior, DB, 6-1, 180

Unanimous All-Big Northern Conference selection recovered a fumble and made six tackles. Biggest contributions came at quarterback (71 of 166 passing, 1,145 yards, eight touchdowns) and also ran for 631 yards and six TDs.



**Andrew Reuter**  
Bartlett, Senior, K, 6-0, 185

Reuter was a key contributor on special teams and defense. He connected on 30 of 34 extra-point attempts and made two field goals, including a game-winner. As a defensive end, he recorded a team-best five sacks and two fumble recoveries.



**Kenny Williams**  
Elgin, Senior, All-Purpose, 6-0, 210

Earned All-Upstate Eight Conference and first-team All-Area honors for third straight year. Ran for 884 yards on 136 carries, had 14 total TDs. Caught 17 passes for 440 yards; made 16 tackles, two sacks at linebacker. Rushed for 3,000-plus yards, scored 38 TDs in career.
