

“Need to Know “ Info for all House Coaches

All coaches need to be aware of some basic league protocols in order to provide a responsible experience for your team.

- **If you have the first scheduled game of the day, you must arrive at least 30 minutes before game time to set-up goals, nets, corner flags, and garbage cans. This applies to both coaches.**
- **If you have the last scheduled game of the day, you must put away the goals, nets, corner flags, and garbage cans. This also applies to both coaches.**
- **You must start your games at the scheduled time. If at game time you do not have a referee, assign a knowledgeable parent to referee. If no parents are available to referee, the coaches must referee their own games.**
- **You must have a field permit for practice. See the field coordinator or your age group coordinator if you do not have a permit.**
- **Please pick up all trash after practice and games. We need to be good citizens to the school district and HARD for the use of their fields.**
- **Control your parents during games. We have youth referees who become discouraged when parents raise their voices at them.**
- **Encourage your parents to volunteer for the field marshall program. This is a good way for parents to help the coaches and obtain a refund on their VPP.**
- **Do not charge your players or parents for equipment, supplies, field use, your time, etc. It is okay to ask for money for pizza parties, or trophies.**
- **If you have any questions or concerns, please utilize your age group coordinator. They are your first contact for all issues.**
