◆ **Registration** – Preparations for the 2009 Fall Soccer Season are underway. Registration for players and coaches will be handled two different ways again this year.

- ◇ **Option 1** (preferred), you may complete and mail the attached registration form with payment to the Registrar, Dave Rothermel, 10 Wintermere Road, Lebanon, PA 17042.
- ◇ **Option 2**, you may register in person at South Lebanon Elementary School on 5/5, 5/6, or 5/11 from 6 to 8pm. Registration will take place in the Large Group Instruction (LGI) room. Enter at the front of the building off Route 897; entrance to the LGI is in the Gymnasium foyer.

This year's registration fees are \$50 for U12 & U14, \$45 for U8 & U10, and \$35 for U6. For multiple registrations within families, the oldest child will be considered the first registrant and any additional child(ren) will be \$20. All checks should be **made payable to Iona Soccer Club** and they must accompany the registration form. **The registration deadline is 6/20. Registrations will be accepted after the deadline on a space available basis ONLY.**

◆ **Soccer Camp** – The Iona Soccer Club will be hosting a summer soccer camp run by UK Soccer again this summer 8/3 to 8/7. Four age appropriate instructional levels will be used: Squirts, 3-4; Nippers, 5-6, Recreation, 7-10; and Premier, 11-16. **The location for the camp will be at South Lebanon Elementary (our home fields).** Additional information can be found on the back of this page or online at www.uksoccercamps.com. ◆ **Coaches Clinic and other Camp Week Events** — The Iona Soccer Club will be providing a coach's clinic, pizza night, and ice cream night during the camp week. More information will be available closer to camp time.

◆ **Practices and Games** – All teams U8 and above will start practice during the week of 7/20. The U6 teams will start practice on 8/11. Practices and games will be held as follows:

- ◇ U12 & U14 girls: Practice—Tues/Thur; Games—weeknights and/or Saturdays.
- ◇ U10 boys & girls: Practice—Mon/Wed; Games—Saturdays.
- ◇ U8 boys & girls: Practice—Tues/Thur; Games—Saturdays.
- ◇ U6 boys & girls combined: Practice and games will be on Tues/Thur.

Shorts will be available from the club at a discount. The board is currently considering plans for replacement of the uniforms in 2010. Under consideration is a plan that will require registrants at the U-12 level and above to purchase their own uniform. Uniforms would include home and away jerseys, shorts and socks and would be offered at a discount through the club. Participants would then be able to wear the uniform throughout their U-12/14 seasons. Details of the plan will be finalized prior to 2010 registration.
