# Jeffersontown Youth Baseball & Softball

## 2012 Divisional Overview

### 5U T-Ball Division - \$125 fee

- Age Requirements – must be 4 on or before April 30 and cannot be 6 on or before April 30
- Batters that show proficiency in practice may receive 3 pitches from coach then hit from tee if unsuccessful (all players bat in 1<sup>st</sup> inning, 3 outs or 6 runs scored per ½ inning after 1<sup>st</sup> inning, 5 infielders)
- Two games per week (one week day and one weekend)
- Up to eighteen league games (Field 6)
- No umpire
- No League Champion and no All-Star game

### 6U Pee-Wee Softball Division (Coach Pitch) - \$125 fee

- Age Requirements – cannot be 7 on or before December 31, 2011
- *NEW for 2012...* provides an opportunity for girls to play with girls utilizing 11" softball
- Compete under modified softball rules (batter receives 5 hittable pitches, keep score, 3 outs or 6 runs scored per ½ inning, 5 infielders plus catcher)
- Two games per week (one week day and one weekend)
- Up to sixteen league games (Field 5 and/or Field 6)

### 6U Pee-Wee Baseball Division (Machine/Coach Pitch – two divisions) - \$140 fee

- Age Requirements – cannot be 7 on or before April 30
- Tryouts for all players (6 year olds that do not tryout are automatically placed in 6U National Division, undrafted 5 year olds fall to T-Ball Division)

#### American Division – Machine Pitch

- Up to six drafted league teams
- Play under modified Machine Pitch rules (35 MPH, no stealing)
- Two games per week (one week day and one weekend)
- Twelve league games (Field 5)
- Games will include at least one umpire
- League Champion will be recognized
- Post-season tournament
- All-Star game – “East vs. West”

#### National Division – Coach Pitch

- Up to eight drafted league teams (includes players not drafted to the American Division)

- Compete under modified baseball rules (batter receives 5 hittable pitches, keep score, 3 outs or 6 runs scored per ½ inning, 5 infielders plus catcher)
- Two games per week (one week day and one weekend)
- Twelve league games (Field 5 and/or Field 6)
- Games will include one umpire
- League Champion will be recognized

### 7U Rookie Baseball Division (Machine Pitch) - \$155 fee

- Age Requirements – cannot be 8 on or before April 30
- Tryouts for all players
- Teams will be drafted under draft system and remain together through 8U Baseball – same team, same coach (unless request to re-enter draft)
- All coaches must be Board-approved and commitment must be confirmed for following season prior to draft
- Play under modified Cal Ripken rules
- Two games per week (one week day and one weekend)
- Twelve league games (Field 7 and/or Field 2)
- League Champion will be recognized
- Post-season tournament
- All-Star teams will be formed based on league vote
- Teams may continue to practice together during baseball off-season

#### Elite Division

- Elite Teams (two) will be formed based on tryouts
- Eight team maximum capacity (non-J-town team cost is \$750)
- Player fee for J-town team is \$100
- Play under modified USSSA rules
- Ten game minimum
- Automatic entry in J-town hosted tournaments
- Sunday games beginning 3/18 (Field 5)

### 8U Rookie Baseball Division (Machine Pitch) - \$155 fee

- Age Requirements – cannot be 9 on or before April 30
- Players will return to the same team and same coach as previous year

- Players requesting to re-enter draft will tryout along with new 8U registrants
- Supplemental draft based on previous year order-of-finish and number of returning players
- Play under modified Cal Ripken rules
- Two games per week (one week day and one weekend)
- Twelve league games (Field 7 and/or Field 2)
- League Champion will be recognized
- Post-season tournament
- All-Star teams will be formed based on league vote
- Teams may continue to practice together during baseball off-season

#### Elite Division

- Elite Teams (two) will be formed based on tryouts
- Eight team maximum capacity (non-J-town team cost is \$750)
- Player fee for J-town team(s) is \$100
- Play under modified USSSA rules
- Ten game minimum
- Automatic entry in J-town hosted tournaments
- Sunday games beginning 3/18 (Field 7 and/or Field 2)

#### 8U Softball Division (Machine Pitch) - \$155 fee

- Age Requirements – cannot be 9 on or before December 31, 2011
- Tryouts for all players
- Teams will be drafted under draft system
- Play under modified Cal Ripken rules
- Two games per week (one week day and one weekend)
- Twelve league games (Field 2 and/or Field 7)
- League Champion will be recognized
- Post-season tournament
- All-Star team will be formed based on league vote

#### 9U/10U Minor Baseball Division - \$155 fee

- Age Requirements – cannot be 10 on or before April 30
- Tryouts for all players
- Teams will be drafted under draft system
- Play under modified Cal Ripken rules
- Two games per week (one week day and one weekend)
- Twelve league games (Field 3 and/or Field 2)
- League Champion will be recognized
- Post-season tournament

- All-Star team will be formed based on league vote

#### Elite Division

- Elite Team will be formed based on tryouts
- Eight team maximum capacity (non-J-town team cost is \$750)
- Player fee for J-town team is \$100
- Play under modified USSSA rules
- Ten game minimum
- Automatic entry in J-town hosted tournaments
- Sunday games beginning 3/18 (Field 2 and/or Field 3)
- 46/65 format, big barrel bats allowed

#### 10U Softball Division (Fast Pitch) - \$155 fee

- Age Requirements – cannot be 11 on or before December 31, 2011
- Tryouts for all players
- Teams will be drafted under draft system
- Play under modified Cal Ripken rules
- Two games per week (one week day and one weekend)
- Twelve league games (Field 2)
- League Champion will be recognized
- Post-season tournament
- All-Star team will be formed based on league vote

#### 10U Minor Baseball Division - \$155 fee

- Age Requirements – cannot be 11 on or before April 30
- Tryouts for all players (10U players will tryout with 12U Division)
- Ten year olds that do not tryout and 10 year olds that are undrafted in 12U National Division are drafted in 9U/10U Minor Division
- Play under modified Cal Ripken rules
- Two games per week (one week day and one weekend)
- Twelve league games (Field 3 and/or Field 4)

#### Elite Division

- Elite Team will be formed based on tryouts
- Eight team maximum capacity (non-J-town team cost is \$750)
- Player fee for J-town team is \$100
- Play under modified USSSA rules
- Ten game minimum
- Automatic entry in J-town hosted tournaments
- Sunday games beginning 3/18 (Field 3 and/or Field 4)
- 46/65 format, big barrel bats allowed

**12U Major Baseball Division (two divisions) - \$155 fee**

- Age Requirements – cannot be 13 on or before April 30
- Tryouts for all players (11/12 year olds that do not tryout are automatically placed in 12U National Division)

American Division – 50/70 format

- Four drafted league teams (11/12 year olds only)
- Play under modified Cal Ripken rules
- Two games per week (one week day and one weekend)
- Twelve league games (Field 4)
- 12U All-Star team will be formed based on league vote (to compete in 12U Cal Ripken 50/70 tournaments)
- 11U All-Star team will be formed based on league vote (to compete in 11U Cal Ripken 50/70 tournaments)

Elite Division

- Elite Team will be formed based on tryouts for 12U
- Elite Team will be formed based on tryouts for 11U
- Sixteen team maximum capacity (non-J-town team cost is \$850)
- Player fee for J-town teams is \$100
- Play under modified USSSA rules
- Ten game minimum
- Automatic entry in J-town hosted tournaments
- One game per week (M/W/Th beginning 3/19 – Field 4)
- 50/70 format, big barrel bats allowed

National Division – 46/65 format

- All 11/12 year olds not drafted to the 12U American Division will be drafted under draft system
- Select 10 year olds, based on tryouts, will be drafted to compete in 12U National Division
- Play under modified Cal Ripken rules
- Two games per week (one week day and one weekend)
- Twelve league games (Field 3 and/or Field 4)
- League Champion will be recognized
- 12U All-Star team will be formed based on league vote (to compete in 12U Cal Ripken 46/60 State Tournament)
- 10U All-Star team will be formed based on league vote from this division

**12U Softball Division (Fast Pitch) - \$155 fee**

- Age Requirements – cannot be 13 on or before December 31, 2011
- Tryouts for all players
- Teams will be drafted under draft system
- Play under modified Cal Ripken rules
- Two games per week (one week day and one weekend)
- Twelve league games (Field 2)
- League Champion will be recognized
- Post-season tournament
- All-Star team will be formed based on league vote

**14U Softball Division (Fast Pitch) - \$180 fee**

- same format as previous

**15U Senior Major Baseball Division - \$180 fee**

- same format as previous
- 13U may be separate division if numbers support
- Elite Team for 13U

**16U Softball Division (Fast Pitch) - \$180 fee**

- same format as previous

**18U Big League Baseball Division - \$180 fee**

- TBD based on level of interest

*Any player may request to “Play-Up” one division (add 1 to the players’ age to determine eligibility). Said player must tryout and be drafted in division requested or they will be returned to their normal division.*
