

Coach's Code of Conduct

Coach – The objective of each coach shall be to implant firmly in the youth in our program the ideals of good sportsmanship, honesty, loyalty, courage and respect for authority. The coach must remember that they hold a position of trust and responsibility in a program that deals with a sensitive and formative period of a youngster's development.

Coaches strongly influence their players. They both share a common interest in the program and have a desire to excel and to win. Coaches must be adults that are sensitive to the mental and physical limitations of the children they coach. We must remember that the program is for the training and enjoyment of the youth involved. Our program will only be as good as the quality of the leadership that is displayed by our coaches.

1. Coaches shall not use profanity at any time to players, coaches, league officials or game officials.
2. Will not be disrespectful to or show a lack of respect for decisions made by program officials.
3. Coaches will conduct themselves in a proper manner during at all times, especially during games, when players are present.
4. Coaches will make an effort to help ensure that all players are afforded an opportunity to participate in practice and games at a level consistent with their skills and abilities.
5. Coaches will elect a representative to from the program to speak on their behalf in front of the program officials to enter constructive criticism and suggestions.
6. Coaches will accept discipline as deemed necessary by the program officials and will use the opportunity to readjust to the goals of the program.
7. Coaches must accept if asked to step aside if, in the opinion of the program officials they are not acting in the best interest of the program at the CYC.
