



**MANCHESTER YOUTH FOOTBALL
Parental Code of Conduct**

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Parental Code of Conduct:

I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, board members and officials at all practices, games, functions and youth sports events.

I will place the emotional and physical well being of the children ahead of my personal desire to win.

I will not approach in a threatening manner or make any threats against any child, coach, official or board member.

I understand that at no time do I approach my child during a game unless asked by the coach.

I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.

I understand that at no time are firearms, drugs or alcohol permitted at Lockhart Field, and I will refrain from using profanity or tobacco in the presence of children at all practices, games, functions and youth sports events. In accordance with OHSAA rules, Lockhart Field is a non-tobacco environment. Use of these substances is limited to the parking areas.

I will remember that the game is for youth - not adults.

I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child and all of the children of MYF and opponents.

I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect and lead by example.

I agree to follow all of the rules and guidelines set down by my organization and by the Buckeye Youth Football Conference to which my organization belongs and abide by the decisions handed down by those organizations.

I, the undersigned, have read and agree to comply with the above and understand that both my child and my participation in Manchester Youth Football are subject to this agreement. I understand that if this agreement is violated that my child and I will be warned and any violations after the warning will result in immediate cancellation of my child's registration and participation in MYF.
