Quick and Easy Steps to Register:

1. Go to www.markhamtennisclub.com after March 21.
2. Click on "Online Forms" from the Main Menu
3. Click on the application form you wish to complete. Start with the "MTC Membership Application" form to become a member. Then choose any of the other application forms to register for your favourite program
4. Complete all required fields in the application form and click the SUBMIT FORM button
5. You will be taken to an online forms summary screen which will allow you to **EDIT** your application, **PRINT** the application (recommended), **DELETE** it, or create another form. Once you are all done, click the **CHECKOUT** button to complete your registration. If you provided an email id, you will be immediately emailed a confirmation.

Please mail in your fee to the address provided, along with a copy of the application form, or drop off at the clubhouse with a monitor, on or after opening day. Note: Please DO NOT include your House league, lesson, or camp fees with your Membership payment. Please separate them for easier tracking & registration.

Registration Tips

- If you need assistance completing your registration or using the website, help is available from executive members listed above.
- If you cannot register online, contact Jim or Lorraine and you will be provided a paper copy of the forms you require. Please keep in mind, however, that in order to reduce costs and keep fees affordable for members, we want to move to online registration exclusively.
- It is our intention to provide all registration notification via email, so it is very important that you include your email address in all registration forms.
- If you don't have PC/internet access at home, you can visit any public library in your neighborhood and get access for free. Simply use your library card (they are FREE as well!) to logon and you're ready to start surfing!
