Please join us for the second annual Mississauga North Instructional Baseball Camp operated by the Ontario Blue Jays Staff and Instructors. The two organizations are pleased to have join forces to provide the facilities and instruction to help the players achieve their goals.

Last year, in our inaugural summer we had over 75 young baseball players participate in our week long camps. The two weeks were such

a huge success that we have decided to add an additional week to this year's schedule.

Last year the entire camp was held at Rivergrove Park in Mississauga. To improve the level of instruction, we have decided to start the day at the Ontario Blue Jays Clubhouse Training Centre - their newly renovated facility. The players will have access to the batting cages, hitting instruction area, pitching mounds, turf fieldhouse room and all of the instructional devices that



make many regard the Ontario Blue Jays Clubhouse the top indoor baseball facility in Canada. Included in this year's camp, each player will receive a video analysis of their

swing (\$120 value) using our state-of-the-art V1 Pro swing analysis software.



In the afternoon, players will be transported via school bus to Rivergrove Park where they receive additional instruction and take part in controlled game play. In the event of inclement weather in the afternoon we would remain inside so weather will never be an issue.

The Ontario Blue Jays are pleased to provide a high level of instruction and top caliber instructors for this camp. Instructors last year included the following:

Jamie Pogue – Ontario Blue Jays 17u Head Coach, played professionally in St. Louis Cardinals organization, former player at Old Dominion University in Virginia, former MVP of IBL, played for Team Canada in World Championships.

Jeremy Ware – played 15 years of professional baseball, reached AAA with the Montreal Expos, also played for Cleveland Indians organization, member of 2004 Canadian Olympic team.



Greg Byron – former professional players with Les Capitaes du Quebec of the Can-Am League and the Washington Wild Things of the Frontier League, currently the Ontario Blue Jays 18u pitching coach.

Jonathan Waltenbury – 7th round draft pick of the Minnesota Twins in 2006, currently plays for the Evansville Otters of the Frontier League, former member of Team Canada.

Nick Forgarty – selected by Milwaukee Brewers in 2008 draft, currently plays at Texarkana College in Texas.

Bryan Condotta – former Ontario Blue Jays player, starting shortstop at Georgia State University.

Arthur Mazierski – former Ontario Blue Jays player, played at Grambling State University in Louisiana, currently an assistant coach at Grambling State.
