Tournament Information

- Games consist of 4 – 10 minute quarters, except 12 and under which is 4 – 8 minute quarters
- Each team is guaranteed 3 games
- Min 25 players and Max 5 coaches per team

Teams

- 16 and under, unlimited weight
- 14 and under, restricted weight – all skilled players must be 176lbs or lighter
- 13 and under, restricted weight – all skilled players must be 161lbs or lighter
- 12 and under, restricted weight – all skilled players must be 146lbs or lighter

INSURANCE

- Our current insurance covers the athletes / coaches and board members at no additional costs
- All players must also obtain and provide proof of additional personal medical coverage (ex. Blue Cross, CAA)

ACCOMODATIONS (cont.)

- Accommodations are based on 30 athletes and 10 support staff, 4 athletes per room, 2-3 per room for JV.
- We are also responsible to pay for the accommodation of the bus driver.

Bussing

- We will be using Coach Canada
- A coach bus carries 55 people
- The drivers will be on duty 15 hours per day while we are in Charlotte
- Extra bus seats will be made available to parents at a pro rata price to help cover some of the costs for the buses



North American Youth Football Championships

Required Documentation (US Entry)

- Each athlete and volunteer will have to have proof of citizenship **(Passport)** with them to allow crossing. All players will be required to provide us with a copy of their passport by October 31 or proof that an application has been made for a passport by that date. The current processing time is 2-3 weeks, If taken directly to the passport office (Central Parkway Mall)
- All athletes travelling without their parents will have to bring a Notarized letter naming Mississauga Warriors Football Club and the volunteers as responsible parties. The Warriors will provide a form of letter for all players. Parents will be responsible to get the letters notarized.

Selection Process

- All athletes will be selected by the coaches of each of the teams
- All coaching staff, managers and chaperones will be selected by the Warriors

Registration Fees

- The cost per athlete and support staff will be about \$500.00 per person
- A non refundable commitment fee of \$250.00 will be due today Sept. 30th, 2008.
- The balance will be due by November 1st, 2009

Commitment and Practices

- In addition to the financial commitment all players are expected to commit to practices prior to leaving for the tournament – practice times and locations, to be confirmed.
- **Please note that players will not be able to participate in any of the practices until their high-school season is over.**

High School Players

- We have confirmed with ROPSSA that the tournament itself does not conflict with ROPSSAA rules. No conflict if after playing season.
- **However, players will not be able to participate in any practices until after their high school seasons are over.**
