## Registration Process Information

(and other important related stuff)

### Registration Process:

- Go to “Need to Know Info” on the main menu of the Warriors website to read important information on fees, eligibility, refund policy and the Warriors’ *Code of Conduct* (Player / Parent Handbook).
- **Read everything carefully.**
- Go to “Register OnLine” in the upper right corner of the home page on the Warriors website
  - In the first field on the form, select the division / team for which you are registering
  - Complete the online form, submit it, print it, but do not sign it.
- Go to “Other Registration Forms” on the main menu
  - Click on “OVFL Form
  - Print the form complete it and bring it to registration.
- Bring the completed forms above, along with photocopies of your birth certificate and Ontario Health Card to the registration session. (**Please Note:** For verification purposes, you must bring the originals of these documents to show the Registrar.) Registration *cannot* be completed unless you have the form and these two documents! )
  - You will also need to bring a second piece of photo identification, such as your driver’s licence or student card
- If you are under 18, you *must* be accompanied by your parent / guardian, so that they can sign the registration and insurance forms in the presence of the Warriors’ Registrar

### Fees:

- There is no change to the registration fees for 2009 !
  - Registration for **Varsity** and **JV** - \$495
  - Registration for **Peewee** - \$395
  - Registration for **Tyke and Atom** - \$300
- Compulsory Fundraiser - \$150
  - The fundraiser has been increased this year, in order to cover higher costs this year
  - **Note:** this can be recovered in full by selling the Warriors’ raffle tickets. ( See **Fundraiser** below)
- Insurance - \$30\*
  - \* **Note:** this is *not* applicable if you have already registered and paid for Winter Camp
- The total for tyke and Atom would be \$300 + \$150 + \$30\* = \$480, for Peewee it would be \$395 + \$150 + \$30\* = \$575 and for JV or Varsity it would be \$495 + \$150 + \$30\* = \$675
- All fees are payable in full by cash, Visa or cheque **by April 1<sup>st</sup> 2009**
- Fees can be paid in three (3) instalments with three post-dated cheques.
  - For example, for JV or Varsity, the payments could be made as follows:
    - \$225 on Feb 15<sup>th</sup>, \$225 on Mar 15<sup>th</sup>, and \$225 on Apr 1<sup>st</sup>
  - The final payment must be made by April 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Send a note to the Registrar if you wish to make instalment payments.

**Note:** Registration for 2009 will not be processed if there are fees still outstanding from 2008 and/or if a player has not returned all of their equipment from the 2008 season.

If you need financial assistance, speak to the Registrar or appropriate Vice President to get information regarding programmes that are available from organizations such as Canadian Tire’s “Jump Start”.

### Family Discount;

- There is a discount for families that have 2 or more children playing for the Warriors.
- A discount of 20% will be applied to the registration fee for the second and third player.
  - For example, if there are players in the same family registered for Varsity and JV, the JV registration would be \$396 rather than \$495
- If the applicable registration fees vary due the divisions / teams, the discount will be applied to the lower fee(s).
  - For example, if there are players in the same family registered for Varsity and Peewee, the Peewee registration would be \$316 rather than \$395
- This discount is not applicable to the fundraising or insurance fees.

**Please note** – Keep your receipt. Registration fees will qualify for the “Children’s Fitness Tax Credit” on your income tax return. Duplicate receipts will not be issued.

### Fundraiser:

- Upon payment in full of all applicable fees (registration, insurance and fundraising), each player will receive \$150 worth of tickets for the Warriors raffle.
- All players must pay the \$ 150 fundraiser fee, but only those paid in full by April 1<sup>st</sup> qualify to recover the funds through the sale of tickets.
- By selling these tickets, each player can recover the \$150. fundraiser fee in full
  - The player keeps the \$150 from ticket sales and returns the completed ticket stubs prior to the July 1<sup>st</sup> draw

### Refund Policy:

Be sure of your commitment. There are no refunds after the first game of the season. Refunds are limited and only for specific situations and/or unless the player is cut by the team. See the Warriors website for details.

### Finally, a few words about equipment:

- Equipment will be handed out to registered players in early April. You must be paid in full to receive your equipment. **No registration / payment = No Equipment !**
- Players are provided with an equipment bag, helmet, pads, practice and game pants, practice and game jerseys, socks and mouth guards.
- Players are fully responsible for their equipment. With the exception of the socks, practice jersey and mouth guard, all equipment must be returned in good condition at the close of the season following the team’s last game.
