

6 AND UNDER DIVISION

SECTION 2.11

2.11.1 Game Length

Games will be six (06) innings, or, no new inning will begin after 1 hour and 10 minutes, whichever comes first. A new inning is considered to have begun immediately after the last batter in the half inning has batted.

2.11.2 Playing Time

All T-BALL players must play all innings of each game. The regular number of players is used in the infield positions. All other players, with no limit, will play the outfield. The outfield is defined as at least ten feet beyond the base lines and will be marked as such. Emphasis shall be placed on all players playing each position throughout the season. Example: designate a player to play one position for two games and then move that player to another position for two games etc.

2.11.3 Batting Eligibility

All Players on the roster will be in the batting order. The batter will stay at bat until the ball is put into play. After the first half, players will have the option to have three (3) pitches from the coach. If they do not put the ball into play from coach pitch then they may hit it off the tee.

2.11.4 Batting Order

In each inning, each team will bat their entire line up.

2.11.5 Pitching

There will be no pitching by players in this division.

2.11.6 Dead Ball

The ball will be dead when it crosses the pitchers circle and runners may not advance any further unless they are beyond the halfway line between bases. The pitcher does not have to have complete control of the ball.

2.11.9 Stealing of Bases

There will be no stealing of bases in this division.

2.11.10 Score Keeping

Since the level of play is to be instructional and not competitive, score keeping will consist of ensuring that the batting order is followed. There should not be any emphasis on scores during or after the game.

There will be no record kept of wins or losses. All players will receive a participation trophy.
