

## MORSL RULE CHANGES PERSONAL BATS (2008)

The following explains new rule changes concerning bats purchased individually, or as a team.

MORSL is governed by NSA Canada (National Slo-Pitch Association of Canada) and as such will follow their recommendations as it pertains to use of legal and illegal bats.

A list of approved bats can be viewed on the NSA CANADA website found at <http://www.nsacanada.ca/bats/approved.htm>. MORSL will also provide a link and/or list on our own website.

1. All bats not supplied by the league must be approved by the Equipment Manager or a member of the executive. Stickers will be supplied to show this bat has been approved for league use.
2. The owner of the bat chooses who may use it. Note: These bats are considered to be personal or team property and not league property.
3. It will be the responsibility of all Captains and Executive to police the use of legal/illegal bats.

### **First offense:**

Any player caught using an illegal bat will be suspended for three games and their team will forfeit their game.

### **Second offense:**

Players caught using an illegal bat a second time will be suspended for the remainder of the year.

No compensation will be provided to the suspended player.

Their team will also forfeit their game.
