On behalf of the North Hunterdon Little League Board of Directors, I want to welcome you to our 2012 season. As with all seasons we begin with our registration process. Like last year, we will again be using online registration (please go to the NHLL web site at [www.nhll.org](http://www.nhll.org) ). This year, your Board of Directors has elected to freeze last year's registration fees for 2012. The cost to register will not increase from last year. However, due to the damage the Jericho complex sustained as a result of Hurricane Irene and the subsequent storm that followed thereafter, we are asking that you kindly consider making a donation to help restore our fields. An option has been added to the registration process where you can elect to make a donation. This is completely optional and no donation is too small. Expenses for the restoration of Jericho are expected to exceed well over \$40,000. While the fields already look great thanks to the hard work of the many volunteers in the NHLL community, they are not complete. Again, please consider donating whatever you feel comfortable with. Last year over 580 boys and girls participated in our Little League Division with an additional 200 players who played in the North Hunterdon Senior League. In our Little League we had played over 500 regular season games along with the crowning of champions following double elimination tournaments at our AA, AAA and Majors Division. Our summer tournament season was also very busy with 160 players playing on teams representing North Hunterdon Little League in various tournaments throughout New Jersey.

I would like to thank you for your continued support of our fundraising efforts. This coming year we will be having our annual raffle and would ask that you use your best efforts to ensure that your son or daughter sells at least the minimum amount of tickets which they are assigned. Remember we are a private organization that receives no funding from any township or recreation department. The costs of maintaining our facilities, purchasing uniforms and equipment and financing the day to day expenses of our league comes solely from registration fees and monies raised through our fundraising activities. In closing, I would like to again thank each and every one of you who participated one way or another in the cleanup efforts following Hurricane Irene.
