## **NYA Basketball Mission Statement**

The Nottingham Youth Association (NYA) is a volunteer, non-profit organization that provides programs to facilitate the personal and educational growth of its young athletes. The Basketball Program aims to provide healthy, challenging basketball instruction and competition to all its participants. The NYA offers basketball opportunities for girls and boys in kindergarten through 8th grade. The focus of this program is on player development and the enjoyment of the game. All NYA teams will establish and implement a policy that provides balanced and fair playing time, and instructional opportunities for every participant. Good sportsmanship is a requirement and must be demonstrated at all times by everyone – players, parents, spectators, and coaches.

## **NYA Basketball Programs**

### **K-2<sup>nd</sup> Program**

The K-2 program is a developmental program open to all kindergarten thru 2<sup>nd</sup> graders. The program runs every Saturday morning from 9:00am to 10:00am. Children learn fundamental basketball skills, through traditional and game skill drills. They also play supervised scrimmages at the end of each session.

### **3<sup>rd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> Program**

The 3rd-4th program compete in the Lamprey River Basketball Developmental League run by the Raymond Recreation Department. This program is not co-ed, there will be both girls and boys teams. Once the teams are selected, each coach will contact the team members and arrange the practice schedule. Each team will practice on one night during the week and play games on Saturday. At the conclusion of the season there will be a NYA skills competition for all participants. At that same time an All-Star team will be selected. The All-Star team will be announced at the banquet. The All-Star team will practice for the month of February and compete in our All-Star tournament, which is held in March. The date of the tournament will be announced later.

### **5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Program**

The 5th-6th and 7th-8th programs compete in the Lamprey River Basketball League run by the Raymond Recreation Department. This program is not co-ed, there will be both girls and boys teams. Once the teams are selected each coach will contact the team members and arrange the practice schedule. The 7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade teams do not generally have regular practices, since most participants also play on school teams during this season and are practicing or playing games almost every day during the week. For the 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Grade Program practices will be held one evening during the week and possible Saturdays during the month of November. Once games begin practices will be held only during the week. Most games are played on Saturdays; however some games may be played on Sundays and even at night during the week. The game schedule will be given to players once the league prepares them. There will be playoffs, and a skills competition at the end of the season.
