Application for a Head Coaching Position

The prospective team manager shall:

- 1) Submit an application to the appropriate League Commissioner during player registration.
- 2) Agree to uphold all policies and carry out all responsibilities delineated herein and in the OHYSA Blue Book. This includes paying membership fees in the OHYSA. (page 6, Section B, part 8, c, 4)
- 3) Initiate or renew membership in the National Youth Sports Coaches Association (NYSCA) through participation in the appropriate clinic if required.
- 4) Be selected at a meeting conducted by the Baseball Commissioner and the individual league commissioners. A Majority vote is required.

Once selected, the Team Manager shall:

- 1) Be responsible at all times for compliance with the rules and regulations of PONY Baseball, Inc., as the rules are applicable to them and their team.
- 2) Be responsible at all times for compliance with the rules and regulations of the Oak Hill Youth Sports Association, as the rules are applicable to them and their team.
- 3) Exercise a maximum effort to maintain a good working knowledge of the fundamentals of baseball and the Official Baseball Rules and Regulations, and shall diligently strive to impart this knowledge to their team.
- 4) Be responsible for the conduct of their team at all times, and shall constantly adhere to the practices of fair play and sportsmanship, and shall promote these qualities in assistants, parents, players and other participants in the program.
- 5) Attend all OHYSA program meetings (i.e., fund-raising activities, concessions*, etc).
- 6) Be responsible for all equipment issued to them and shall insure that necessary precautions are taken to prevent abuse or loss. They must also return issued equipment promptly after the end of the season.
- 7) Participate in all field and facility maintenance activities associated with the OHYSA Baseball program*.
- 8) Recruit additional adult volunteers to assist in a variety of game-related duties (i.e., score-keeping, concessions, field maintenance, etc.).
- 9) Insure that the playing field and dugouts are clean and orderly after each game or practice.
- 10) Refrain from drug use and be alcohol and tobacco free at all youth sporting activities, and encourage the same from your players.
- 11) Wear an approved OHYSA coach's shirt during all league and tournament games.
- 12) Remember that the physical, mental, emotional and spiritual welfare of the players is of first importance.

* Failure to perform this duty will result in that team receiving a forfeit of one winning ball game at the end of the regular season.

The team manager shall not:

- 1) Hold the office of League Commissioner of the league in which they manage.
- 2) Serve as a Division Player agent in the league in which they manage.
- 3) Serve as a team manager of a second team in the OHYSA program.
