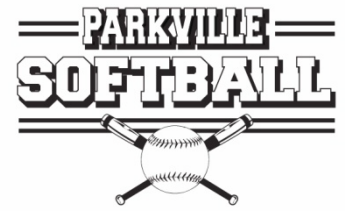


## 2012 Season News & Updates
