Umpires for 8U Coach Pitch

The Pasadena Baseball Club is looking for high school aged students with baseball or softball playing experience to umpire our 8 and under (8U) coach pitch division games. At the choice of the student, acceptable applicants will receive either \$20 per game, or 2 hours of volunteer service per game.

8U Coach Pitch Division:

- Most games are on weeknights and start at 6pm
- Weekend games are less common but typically would start at 9am, 11:30am, 2pm, or 5:30pm
- Typical games are about 1 ½ hours, and there is a “no-new-inning” time limit after 1:45
- Our 8U Coach Pitch division is all coach-pitch – no kid pitch. There are no balls and strikes, just 6 pitches or three swings per batter. Call safe/out on the bases. Keep track of outs per inning.
- There will be approximately 55 games to be umpired during the 8 week season – mid April to mid June.
- There may be additional opportunities before, during, and after our regular season.
- Umpires are paid \$20 cash before the start of the game – unless they choose service hours

Requirements:

- Umpires must be enrolled in high school, and should have playing experience above coach pitch level
- Umpires must attend a one-day training session to review and demonstrate knowledge of our coach pitch division rules. *Rules are available online at www.PasadenaBaseball.org, select Intramural Baseball, and then “2007 Intramural Playing Rules”.*
- Umpires must show up on the field and be ready to work 5 minutes before start time
- Umpires must wear approved attire. With scheduling of a minimum number of games, the Club will provide an umpire shirt to be worn.

Selection Based on:

- Knowledge of our coach pitch rules
- Confidence working with adults and children
- Ability to calmly control a game and avoid confrontational behavior

Mr. Engel will contact all applicants to let them know their status. Once accepted, umpires will provide their schedule availability to Mr. Engel who in turn will schedule umpires approximately two weeks in advance of scheduled games.
