This year we are asking players/families that are in need of partial or full financial assistance for Boosters Dues (\$100) and/or the Team Camp (\$225) to fully participate in volunteer positions (parents) and fundraisers (players). Certainly if times are tough we can count on you or your son to assist in a non-monetary way. Below find the activities that can offset your financial assistance needs.

Players: Fund Raising / Gold Cards

This year each player will be asked to sell a minimum number of Gold Cards during two, one-day organized team blitz events. Each Gold Card sold generates \$12 for the booster club. In past years, a one-day sales event resulted in each player selling between 10 and 40 cards with the standard/required amount being 20. Therefore, a simple way to offset financial assistance is to sell an extra 9 Gold Cards for Boosters Dues and/or an extra 19 cards for the Team Camp.

By accepting the Booster Clubs Financial Assistance you (the player) are agreeing to participate, to a greater degree, in the Gold Card fundraiser and to strive to sell the standard amount plus the extra amount of cards.

Parent: Volunteering – many positions

There are many positions still open that help fund the Booster Club. For example:

- 1) 50/50 sales during games
- 2) Game Day Sales Coordinator for Game Programs
- 3) Selling Game Day Programs
- 4) Working at the Fan Store during games

When you (the parent) accept the Booster Club's Financial Assistance it is expected that you would volunteer in one of the mentioned activities for the season (7 home games).

In addition there are other Volunteer Positions open for the 2009 season:

- 1) Pasta Party contributors
- 2) Freshman game day photographer
- 3) JV game day photographer
- 4) Pre-season picnic assistant

Please note that the Radnor Gridiron Booster Club does not get funding from the Radnor High School.

Financial assistance comes from your fellow players' dues and our fundraising. Dues and fundraising pay for the following items for each player:

1 Radnor Football T-shirt	\$10
End of Year Banquet	\$30
Team pictures	\$15
Volunteer Coaches Pay	\$100 (\$8,000 divided by 80 players)
Website	\$10
Senior gifts	\$TBD
