



DUNFERMLINE REIGN BASKETBALL CLUB

CONSTITUTION AND RULES

1. The club shall be called Dunfermline Reign Basketball Club.
2. **Object:** To encourage the playing of basketball by club members in both Local and National League Competitions at CADET, JUNIOR and SENIOR Men's levels.
3. **Membership:** The club shall comprise those members who pay the annual subscription. Players may not be registered by another club affiliated to the Scottish Basketball Association. Membership is open to all and no application for membership will be refused on other than reasonable grounds. There will be no discrimination on the grounds of race, occupation, sex or religious, political or other opinion.
4. **Affiliation:** The club shall affiliate to the Scottish Basketball Association and pay the appropriate affiliation fees.
5. **Registration:** All paying members who are to represent the club in competitions organised by the National or Regional Association, will be registered with the Association and pay the appropriate fees.
6. **General Meetings:** The Club shall meet in General Meeting at least once in each year, after two weeks notice has been given to each member. The Meeting shall be held before the Annual General Meeting of the Association and Regional Association. The following shall be included in the business transacted:
 - Presentation of Report of the Committee and accounts for the year preceding the meeting;
 - Presentation of Reports;
 - Election for the ensuing year of Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer and 2 other members who will stand for the Club Committee;
 - Preparation of motions the AGM of the Association or Regional Association;
 - Approval of annual subscription.
7. **Club Committee Meetings:** These shall be held once every two months or more often as deemed necessary.
8. **Voting:** All paid-up members of the Club for the season will be entitled to a vote. A quorum will comprise of 2/5ths of the Club Membership.
9. **Administration:** Any contingency not covered by this Constitution should be referred to the Rules of the Scottish Basketball Association for guidance.
10. **Changes to the Constitution:** No changes may be made to the Constitution without 2/3rds majority at a General Meeting of the Club.
11. **Dissolution:** If, upon the winding up or dissolution of the Club there remains, after the satisfaction of all the Club's debts and liabilities any property whatsoever the same shall be given or transferred to some other organisation or organisations having objectives (that is aims and activities) similar to the objectives of the Club, such organisation or organisations to be determined by the members of the Club by resolution passed at a General Meeting at or before the time of the dissolution, and in so far as effect cannot be given to such provision then to some charitable objects.
