Camp Mission

Our mission at Ram Basketball Camp is to encourage and assist growth in our campers through the game of basketball. Our coaches place an emphasis on individual skill development, which includes training in shooting form, ball handling, passing and offensive moves. We also stress training in defensive principles, rebounding, and conditioning as well as the importance of citizenship and team building. Participants will practice these fundamentals daily during skill stations and full court games.

Camp Director

Coach Kissal completed his 14th season coaching basketball at the collegiate and high school levels in the D.C. Metropolitan area and his second as the head coach of Rockville High School. The Rams began the 2008-09 season 4-0, the school's best start in over 20 years. His coaching career has included stints at Good Counsel HS (1995-2000), Catholic University (2000-02), Bishop McNamara HS (2002-04), and The Bullis School (2004-06). In that span, Coach Kissal's teams won 1 Division III National Championship (Catholic), 3 Conference Tournament Championships (Catholic, Bullis), and 4 Conference Regular Season Championships (Good Counsel, Catholic, Bullis). Coach Kissal has had the opportunity to coach 14 Division I basketball players, including Roger Mason (San Antonio Spurs/Virginia), James Gist (Maryland), Adrian Bowie (Maryland) and Tywon Lawson (North Carolina).
