What is Winter Soccer?

Winter Soccer represents the opportunity for the best and most committed high school age players to compete on a Statewide level against the best teams and players in age pure competition.

RVSC will be working with the Ashland Soccer Club, Grants Pass Soccer Club and Basin United Soccer Club in order to provide the most competitive experience possible for the players in Southern Oregon!

Our goal is to assemble teams at the U15, U16, U17, U18/19 age groups for both boys and girls.

Why Play Winter Soccer?

The Rogue Valley Soccer Club's Winter Soccer Program objective is to provide the most committed and passionate soccer players in our area an opportunity to compete against the best teams and players in the state. We are committed to exposing players with a desire to possibly compete on a collegiate level to college coaches through league play, showcase tournaments and State Cup competition.

Upon selection to a team, you will be invited to a college recruiting night. At this time we will go over recruiting time lines, rules and regulations. We will be providing information as to the steps each student athlete must take from their Freshman year on to give them the best chance to continue their playing career past high school. Our coaches are committed to working with each player to insure that they are performing both athletically and more importantly academically throughout their high school years!

What is the timing of the season?

Tryouts will take place December 1st for girls and December 3rd for boys. They will be held from 6 to 9 at US Cellular Park in Medford.

Training will begin almost immediately after the tryout process is complete. We will take Christmas through New Years off and resume training on January 2nd. Training will be held at US Cellular Park.

Some teams will attend a college showcase tournament in Portland in the middle of January.

League play begins January 21 and runs through the middle of April

State Cup/President's Cup begins in April and runs through the beginning of May

RV Cup is played over Memorial Day Weekend

We will encourage our coaches to attend at least 1 college Showcase over the summer.

Playing in State Cup and Showcase Tournaments, gives our players the best opportunity to be recognized and recruited by college coaches.

How much does it cost?

The RVSC fee is \$150.00. This fee covers player registration and insurance, administrative costs, field rental and coaching stipend.

We will be offering a \$50.00 Nike Uniform
League Fees will be an additional \$40.00 to \$50.00 (depending on roster size)

State Cup, College Showcase Tournaments and Rogue Valley Cup will be additional fees that will not be due until a later date and again will be determined by roster size.

Travel expenses are not included. Please plan to make 3 to 4 over night trips between the end of January and beginning of May. We will put 4 to 5 player to a hotel room in order to keep hotel expense to a minimum!

RVSC and their coaching staff will make every effort possible to keep the expenses to a minimum. Teams are encouraged to do fund raising events or seek sponsorships in order to lower individual expenses.

There is a LIMITED amount of financial aid available. Arrangements for financial aid must be discussed prior to the tryouts!
