



RVSC PLAYING UP PETITION

An excerpt from 'The RVSCCC Policies and Procedures for Player Selection'

"RVSC encourages all players to play at their own age level as identified by OYSA. In accordance with USSF rules, no U-10 player can play in any competitive league.

Playing Up: Players considering trying out for an age level above their own should discuss this with the team head coach or the head coach of the competitive league at or before preregistration for guidance in deciding which level would best suit the player. The player that decides to tryout for a higher age level, must submit the RVSC "Playing Up Petition", signed by the player's guardian, **at or before** the first night of tryouts. Players deciding to tryout for a higher age level team will, on the first day of tryouts, get feedback from the team head coach. The player may then weigh this feedback and decide at which age level to tryout on the second night of tryouts. Once the player tries out at their own age level they can no longer be considered for another age level team based on the current years tryouts.

"I understand that my son / daughter may be more at risk for injuries "playing up" than one who is playing at their own age level. If at tryouts my son/daughter makes a higher age bracket competitive team, my child and I understand and accept this risk and take full responsibility for the placement of my son daughter on the team".
