Recreation Rules

Equipment:

- *All players must be wearing Shin Guards before entering the field of play. Players not wearing shin guards will not be allowed to play.*
- *Player's socks need to cover Shin Guard*
- *No Football or Baseball cleats may be worn, only soccer cleats, turfs, or tennis shoes/sneakers*
- *No jewelry may be worn on the field, i.e. watches, earrings, necklaces, bracelets, etc. Medical Alert Bracelets are the only exception and they must be taped down. Taping of Jewelry is not permitted!*
- *No equipment shall be worn that is considered dangerous to another player as determined by the referee.*

Rosters:

- *All teams are to present a laminated roster from RVSC, signed by Laurie Staff our club registrar to the referee before each game. If a player is not on the roster they can't play that weekend until you receive a new roster, period!!*

Game Ball:

- *Game balls are provided by the home team listed on the schedule
U-7, U-8, U-9, U-10 & U-12 use a size 4 ball. U-14's use a size 5 ball.*

Protests:

- *All games will be considered final. NO PROTESTS WILL BE ALLOWED.*

Sportsmanship:

- *Good sportsmanship will prevail at all times. Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their players, assistant coaches, parents and spectators.*

Sideline behavior:

- *A coach may not enter the field of play except on the referee's signal.*
- *Coaches, players, parents and spectators shall not harangue or attempt to distract players, linesman or center referee(s). Infraction of these rules will result in a caution, followed by a ejection and appropriate disciplinary action as determined by the club Judicial Board. No coach is to make derogatory remarks or gestures to the referee, players or spectators. Any coach, player, or spectator making derogatory remarks or gestures to the referee, players or spectators will be asked to leave the field for the remainder of the game!*
- *Spectators are not allowed to coach*
- *ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND SMOKING ARE PROHIBITED ON ALL FIELDS. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!*

Jersey Conflict:

- *In the event of a conflict in jersey colors, the home team will effect a color change. Goalkeepers must wear a color clearly disguising them from all other players and referees.*

Home Team:

- *The home team listed first on the schedule is the home team for that game.*

Substitutions:

- *Substitutions for U-6, U-7, and U-8 will be made during every 5-minute period. UNLIMITED SUBSTITUTIONS MAY BE MADE, WITH THE CONSENT OF THE REFEREE, ON ANY DEAD BALL (This is for U-9 through U-14). Substitutions are made at the centerline with the consent of the referee.*

Player Safety:

- *No player may play if they bleeding or there is blood on their uniform. The referee will immediately substitute the player. The uniform must be changed. The player may not return to the game until the bleeding is stopped and the wound is covered.*

No Littering:

- *Please respect the fields made available to the Rogue Valley Soccer Club and be considerate of the fields and their owners. Please at the conclusion of your game, all garbage generated by your team be collected and disposed of in a trash receptacle.*

1. *U-7 & U-8 Boys and Girls play (2) 20 min halves separated into (4) 5-minute periods. With 30 seconds between each period. After the first 4 periods you take a 5-minute half time and then play the next 4 periods.*
2. *Both teams are to be on the same side of the field and all parents are to be on the opposite side of the field from the players and coaches.*
3. *All teams are to present a laminated roster from the RVSC and signed by Laurie Staff our club registrar to the referee before each game. If a player is not on the roster they can't play that weekend until you receive a new roster, period!!*
4. *No PK's, everything is an indirect kick!!*
5. *They are no goalkeepers at this age level!!*
6. *There are no off sides.*
7. *No slide tackling is allowed at this age level!!!*
8. *Bad throw-ins are given back to the same player for a re-throw.*

9. *U-9 Boys and Girls play (2) 25 minute halves with a 5 minute half time*
10. *Both teams are to be on the same side of the field and all parents are to be on the opposite side of the field from the players and coaches.*
11. *No PK's, everything is an indirect kick.*
12. *There is Goalkeepers*
13. *There are no off sides.*
14. *No slide tackles*
15. *Subs at the 50 yard line, only with the referees permission*
16. *Re-dos on throw ins.*

17. *U-10 Boys and Girls play (2) 25 minute halves with a 5 minute half time*
18. *Both teams are to be on the same side of the field and all parents are to be on the opposite side of the field from the players and coaches.*
19. *There are goalkeepers*
20. *No PK's, everything is an indirect kick*
21. *No re-dos on throw-ins*
22. *Yes there is off sides*
23. *No slide tackles*
24. *Subs at the 50 yard line, only with the referees permission*

25. *U-12 Boys and Girls play 30 minute halves with a 5 minute half time*
26. *Both teams are to be on the same side of the field and all parents are to be on the opposite side of the field from the players and coaches.*
27. *Yes there is off sides*
28. *No re-dos on throw-ins*
29. *No slide tackles*
30. *No PK's, everything is an indirect kick*
31. *Subs at the 50 yard line, only with the referees permission*

32. U-14 Boys and Girls play 35 minute halves and 5 minute half time
33. Both teams are to be on the same side of the field and all parents are to be on the opposite side of the field from the players and coaches.
34. Yes there is off sides
35. No re-dos on throw ins
36. No slide tackles
37. There are PK's for serious penalties
38. Subs at the 50 yard line, only with the referees permission
