

Concession Stand Duty Rules:
Sam Bass Team Fundraising

1. Concession Prep – 2-3 volunteers will be needed from the participating team to load/unload food from the Sam Bass shed and transfers over to the Pflugerville fields Between the Hours of 10 am and 1 pm. **Failure to adhere to this request will result in a deduction of fundraising monies for that event.**
2. Scheduled Coverage - Team volunteers need to be scheduled 45 minutes before the start of the first game and close only after the last game is completed. A minimum of at least 3 volunteers scheduled during all shifts. **5 volunteers need to be scheduled between 11am until 5pm for maximum efficiency and service.**
3. Acceptable Volunteers – Parents and immediate family members from the participating team are eligible for concession stand duties. Volunteers under the age of 12 years must be accompanied by an adult in concession stand. **There must always be an adult present.**
4. No outside food/drinks can be served in concession stand unless purchased by SB. In order to maximize the team's profitability, the consumption of "free food" is prohibited by volunteers during shift work. This includes family and friends.
5. No fundraising will be done in conjunction with concession stand duty (tip jars, raffles, etc...). Raffle tickets can be sold outside concession Stand
6. No alcohol will be stored or consumed in the concession stand.
7. Concession area and equipment needs to be cleaned at the end of both evenings (including floor).
8. Closing procedure (Sunday evening) – Closing volunteers will need to bring back surplus boxes of food/candy/drinks back to the Sam Bass shed. Refrigerated/perishable food needs to be put back in refrigerator or freezer.
9. Payment - Concession area, refrigerator and freezer will be inspected and approved by the designated Board Member before payment is to be made to the team.
