Parents/guardians are expected to volunteer ONE time during the season at our home game or other SCPW-hosted events. And yet, several parents have been asked and have agreed to, or have been assigned to a volunteer job and have not shown up. Some parents have ditched their time twice and we've only hosted 2 games plus the jamboree. When you don't show up parents who have already been working for 90 minutes and should be leaving to watch their child's game feel obligated to stay on the job, or we can't offer all of the things that are expected from us at games; like the 50/50 or merchandise. The 50/50 raffle was only held 2 times this past Sunday and the merchandise table had to be shut down before the last game even started. Not only do we miss the opportunity to give money away or to outfit a kid in the sweatshirt he's been waiting to buy but we miss the opportunity to raise crucial funds for our league. Your child has to be here 90 minutes before their game for warm ups and practice and that's exactly the time we need you. Volunteer your time while they get ready for the game and then you don't miss your game. For each game there should be a person at the gate to collect donations, a person selling 50/50 tickets, a person in the merchandise tent and two people in the concession stand. In addition, 3 people are needed to hold chains during the game prior to your child's game. This job offers the best seat in the house – right on the field! Please find your team parent and sign up for a shift. And then, show up! Please remember that **ALL** of Pop Warner is run by VOLUNTEERS (no one gets paid!!) and even though you sign you son or daughter up to participate in Cheer or football, that if we don't have volunteers to help our association as well as at the Central Mass, Regional and National... **NONE** of our children would be participating in Pop Warner. We understand that everyone has jobs and families to attend too, but so do the people who put in countless hours on a weekly and daily basis to make this all possible for all of our children... **AND A BIG THANK YOU TO THOSE WHO DO STEP UP WEEK AFTER WEEK TO HELP US OUT!**

Directions to Grafton High School (30 Providence Rd , Grafton) for Jr. Midgets:

35 minute ride

Rte 395 North to US-20 via Exit 6A. Drive 6.7 miles and turn right onto Grafton St/Rte 122. Drive 3 1/2 miles and turn a slight right onto Providence Rd.

Directions to Springfield (provided by Springfield Pop Warner Longhorns):

About a 50 minute ride

Take the Mass. Pike (Rt. I-90) West to Rt. 291 in Chicopee . Follow Rt. 291 to Rt. I-91 South in Springfield . Take exit 4 (Summer Av to Rt. 83.). Take a left, under the highway. After the first traffic light, turn right, up Longhill Street . At the traffic light go left on Summer Ave. Forest Park is on the right.

Directions to Winchendon (3 Memorial Dr) for JPW2:

One hour, 20 minute ride

Rte 395 North to 290 East to 190 North via exit 19. Take Exit 8A towards Fitchburg and drive 12 miles. Take Exit 24B to Rte 140 North and drive 9.3 miles. MA-140 becomes Spring St. Drive 2.3 miles and turn right onto Central St/US-202. Drive just under one mile and Central St becomes Elmwood Rd. Drive 2/10 of a mile and turn left onto Memorial Drive.
