Sharpsburg Youth Football Association Announces Early Bird Registrations.

Sharpsburg Youth Football Association (SYFA) announces "Early Bird Registrations" on January 6, 2009, at 6:30 p.m. Eastern.

January 7, 2009 [Sharpsburg Youth Football Association](http://www.sharpsburgfootball.com), a competitive sports association formed to accommodate the children of Coweta County ages 5-14, today announced the opening of "Early Bird Registrations" for football and cheerleading.

"Early Bird Registrations" begins the 2009 football season for SYFA in laying the ground work for another successful year. Early registration is by mail in only until February 12, 2009 and will not be extended. Registration forms can be downloaded from www.sharpsburgfootball.com. The cost for early registration will be \$170.00 which includes the \$20 raffle ticket.

The goal of the 'Early Bird Registration' is to raise awareness of the SYFA youth sports program early on. In 2008, SYFA had over 500 children register with many more inquiring after final registration had closed. By opening up the registration process early and providing a discount to normal registration fees, this should allow for more visibility around the county into the SYFA program.

After February 12, 2009, early registration will be closed and the normal registration will take place. The cost for normal registration will be \$220.00 which includes the \$20.00 raffle ticket. Out of county registrants this year will be charged an "Out of County Impact Fee" of \$5.00 per child.

SYFA has also created a family initiative for those registering more than one child. This plan will grant the second child within the immediate family a 10% discount while additional children within the immediate family receive a 15% discount.

"We're excited to welcome the players and cheerleaders of our community to what is sure to be another successful year", said Mark Doss, SYFA President. "We want to build off what was a highly successful 2008 season which delivered one Super Bowl Champion

and one Super Bowl runner up in the Southern Youth Football Conference, while the Elite III and Elite II Cheerleading Squads were crowned Grand Champions in cheering competitions”.
