Registration Information:

Deadline: February 28, 2010. Teams are formed based on the availability of fields, volunteers, and on a first-come, first-served basis. Teams may fill before this date, especially in the younger age divisions. **Please, register early!** Registrations can be accepted after February 28th, but those players may be put on a waiting list.

Qualifications: Players must either: be residents of Wauwatosa, or attend school in Wauwatosa.

Age: Baseball Players must either: be between the ages of 7 - 14 as of September 1, 2010 or be in 1st -8th grade for the '09-'10 school year. Proof of age must accompany this registration, unless submitted in an earlier season. A copy of a birth certificate is sufficient. Once received, this proof of age is kept on file with the league for the duration of a child's eligibility.

Fees: **SELECT ONE:** \$ 120 Registration

\$ 145 Registration, including Candy Option: a box of candy, delivered at the beginning of the season (early May). The player/player's family keeps the money collected from selling the candy.

NOTE: This option available only until April 1 when League candy order is placed.

NOTE: Full payment and a completed registration form must be received for any player to be considered registered with the league.

Team Uniform Sponsorships: Local businesses can sponsor a single team or even an entire division. Company logos are silk-screened on the backs of league uniform shirts. Sponsors are also listed on the league web site with a link to their own home page, if desired. A team appreciation plaque is included.

Notification: The League Draft, at which players are assigned to teams, is held in April. Shortly thereafter, you will be notified by mail as to which team your child has been placed, as well as the coach's name and phone number. The coach will then call to introduce him or herself, and schedule team practices.

Participation: Children (and their parents), today, have many activities to participate in. Baseball, being a team sport, depends on the unity of a team and commitment of each player on the team. Prior to registering, please consider the amount of time you and your child can invest. Attendance is expected at team practices and league games, understanding that summer is the time for family activities.

Medical Emergencies: Generally, consent to treat a minor injury must be obtained from the parent or guardian. In the event of a life threatening emergency, medical treatment may proceed without consent. The parents or guardians will be sought out, but, if necessary, a court order may be obtained to continue treatment, once the emergency has passed, and if no third party has been authorized to consent to medical care. To expedite the care of your child during your absence, it is best to leave a witness statement with the adult (person 18 years old or older) to whom you are entrusting your child.

League Information: Tosa Baseball League, Inc. is an independent league and is not affiliated with any "Little League" organization. There are currently four age divisions within the co-ed baseball league. The Rookie Division is for 7 & 8 year-olds, the World Division for 9 & 10 year-olds, the American Division for ages 11 & 12, and the National Division for ages 13 & 14. The Rookie Division uses pitching machines, while the other Divisions have players pitch. The number of teams fielded in each division depends on the number of fields available, the number of volunteers for key positions, and the number of registrations received.

Tosa Girls Fast Pitch League is affiliated with Tosa Baseball. There are three age divisions: the Minor Division is for 7, 8 & 9 year olds, the Major Division is for 10, 11 & 12 year-olds, and the Senior Division is for 13, 14 & 15 year-olds. The number of teams fielded in each division depends on the number of fields available, the number of volunteers for key positions, and the number of registrations received. A separate softball registration form is available on the TBL website.

Players are randomly placed on teams through the league draft, if a) they are new to the league, b) are eligible to move to the next division, or c) they request to go to a new team. There are no tryouts. Players whose parents or guardians have volunteered for key positions will be placed on teams so that all teams are staffed with coaches, umpires, and managers. If eligible by age, players will remain on the same team as the prior year.

It is the intent of the league to balance teams throughout the league by age, without regard for schools or neighborhoods of residence. Therefore, the league does not honor requests for special placement of players on teams. Practices are arranged by individual coaches at their convenience during May and possibly continuing into the season. **Schedules** will be distributed by coaches or managers. Each team will generally play two-three games per week throughout June and July.

Following the regular season, there is a **Tournament**. The Girls' Softball Tournament is late June. The Baseball Tournament is in late July. It's structured to give teams additional games to play, and to allow those teams that may have finished lower in league standings to get a new start with a "second season."

Volunteers make the league work, so please, get involved. Coaches, umpires and managers receive league-sponsored training. The league is administered by a volunteer Board of Directors made up of parents of players, just like yourself. The Board meets once a month (except August & December) at the Hart Park Pavilion. Anyone interested is welcomed and encouraged to offer their constructive input on the running of the league.
