



Since 1971, Tosa Baseball League has offered Wauwatosa children ages 7 to 14 the opportunity to learn and play baseball and softball in an educational yet fun environment. With an emphasis on sportsmanship and teamwork, our children learn lessons that go well beyond baseball.

More than 600 families participate in Tosa Baseball each year on more than 40 co-ed baseball teams and girls softball teams. Tosa Baseball is truly a family activity as we rely on parent volunteers to coach, umpire and help organize each team.

Our Code of Conduct insures a positive, fun environment. We instruct and challenge our players to be competitive, but we make sure to maintain the proper perspective.

With an emphasis on safety, it is necessary that Tosa Baseball provides quality equipment to all of our players. We need to regularly replace equipment, and it is important to our league that parents are comfortable with the equipment that their children are using.

Tosa Baseball outfits more than 650 players each year with caps and uniforms. All bats and balls are provided. In our youngest co-ed baseball division – 7 and 8 year olds – we utilize pitching machines so that our youngest players have the best opportunity to see quality pitches and insure their development as hitters. Batting helmets, full catcher’s gear, and bats are provided for more than 40 teams.

We also supply equipment for all of our umpires. Additional training tools, such as batting tees, are also provided.
