

## **2009 Tri-Boro Little League Anderson Field Rules**

1. Snack Stand clock will serve as the official time
2. The Home team manager is responsible for picking up the keys from the police station and opening up the field. After the completion of the game the keys need to be handing off to the next games home team manager. The manager of the last game of that day needs to return the keys to the police station.

### **Week Day Games Monday-Thursday & Sundays**

3. **1<sup>st</sup> game** must START by 6:00pm (5:30pm is recommended) and 6:15pm is the official forfeit time. All games will end at 7:45pm **NOTE\* if inning is not finished score will revert back to last inning and will be official.**
4. **2<sup>nd</sup> game** must START by 8pm and 8:15 is the official forfeit time. All games will end by 10:15pm **NOTE\* if inning is not finished score will revert back to last inning and will be official.**

### **Weekend Games Friday & Saturday**

All games will end by 10:45pm **NOTE\* if inning is not finished score will revert back to last inning and will be official.**

5. Game Start and End times are based on this rule document approved by the board of directors and can only be changed by the league president.
6. No on deck batters, no “donuts”, and no holding bats in dugout. Bats should only be in hand on the way to the plate.
7. No players are to warm up off the field on the blacktop. Pitchers & catches are to warm up in foul territory along the first and third base outfield lines during their time at bat. Catches must be in full gear with their backs towards home plate. Pitchers will be facing home plate. A third player last in the order will be in front of the catcher wearing a helmet and glove to protect the catcher.
8. Batters must wear protective NOCSAE helmets.
9. Catchers must wear helmet/mask with throat protector, chest protector, shin guards and protective cup.
10. Players warming up game pitchers must wear helmet/mask with throat protector. Coaches are not permitted to warm up game pitchers.
11. Both teams of the 1<sup>st</sup> game are responsible to get the field ready for play; remove tarps, insert bases, rake where needed, line field and batters box.
12. Both teams of the 2<sup>nd</sup> game are responsible for field clean up and lock up; drag field, put tarps in place, clean dugouts, empty all garbage cans, inspect and clean the field house, check that all doors are locked, check that all lights have been turned out and return keys to the police station.
13. Each team is responsible to have a parent in the snack stand 15 minutes prior to game time. No one except the staff working the stand is permitted inside the snack stand. The home team is responsible to have a parent for the clubhouse to announce and run the scoreboard. There are NO kids allowed in clubhouse under the age of 12 without an adult. This is the responsibility of both team managers to enforce to their team parents.
