- *I will place the emotional and physical well being of all players ahead of a personal desire to win.*
- *I will treat each player as an individual, and expect age appropriate skills from all players.*
- *I will provide a safe playing atmosphere for all players.*
- *I will teach my players in a nurturing, positive manner.*
- *I will teach my players to play fair, exhibit good sportsmanship at all times, do their best, and that winning or losing is not the most important thing in the game.*
- *I will teach players to respect the game of baseball. I will remember that I am a youth sports coach and the game is for the players.*
- *I will adhere to and respect this Code of Conduct while participation in any league activity.*
- *I will communicate with all parents of players on my team in a respectful, positive manner. I will listen to their questions, and advise them how to help their child's experience in T.Y.R.A. Baseball/Softball.*
- *If I do not abide by the above rules, I will be subject to: 1) Verbal warning from organization official. 2) Written warning for organization Official. 3) One game suspension from the organization President. 4) Season Suspension.*
- *Coaches are appointed yearly by the Organization President.*
- *If I am ejected by an umpire for any reason, I will serve a one game automatic suspension, away from the field, and no appeal will be allowed.*
