

## UPPER ISLAND COACHES AND CLUBS

2007/2008

The following items are in effect this season:

- UISA Line-up & Misconduct form will be used for all games from U-13 to U-18. Form to be supplied by the Home team. Forms must be filled out by both teams properly and completely before handing to REFEREE before start of game
- ID cards are mandatory for all League and Cup games (U-13 - U-18). ID cards will be required for the first league game of the season. All Players and Team Officials must have ID cards by OCT 15/07. NON Conforming Players or Team Officials may be subject to Sanctions by UISA.
- Teams Must have a team official of the same sex on the bench as the players on the team, per BCSA Policy
- Fields must have Technical areas and dotted spectator lines, minimum 2 meters from sideline
- Teams and spectators will be on opposite sides of the field for all games. No coaching from spectator side of field, coaches are asked to help enforce this. Referees will be made aware of this and told to report offending teams. Team officials must control technical area
- A player receiving a RED card or a TEAM official reported for misconduct must sit out their next game automatically.
- While under suspension, the player or team official's name must still appear on the team list with SUSPENDED written in place of ID #. A person under suspension is not allowed to be on the team side of field.
- A player receiving 3 yellow cards in a playing season, including cup play up to the DISTRICT level, must sit out their next game automatically.
- Suspension fulfillment only counts in league and cup games.
- While under suspension the person is not allowed to participate in ANY soccer activities i.e. games, practices, training sessions or any other activities related to soccer, including exhibition or friendly games, unless written permission is received from Upper Island Discipline Committee.
- Discipline for players will be dealt with initially at the club level, Team official discipline will be dealt with at the DISTRICT level.
- Schedule changes, requests or concerns must come through your Club Rep or President in writing.
