Van Buren Recreation

The Van Buren Recreation program is designed for children all ages who are interested in soccer at a beginner and intermediate level at a low cost. **No tryouts needed.** You do not have to be a resident to join.

Recreation Practice Information

- Practice time, place & frequency are totally up to the volunteer coach's.
- Practice fields in Van Buren Township include North & South middle schools, Elwell, Edgemont, Tyler & Savage Elementary Schools.
- Coach's usually practice 2 times per week after 5:00pm.
- Each child will need to bring their own soccer ball & water bottle to practice.

Recreation Game Information

- First games start the week after Easter.
- Each team will play 8-10 games, depending on the amount of teams registered.
- All U6-U8 games will be played at Quirk Park directly behind the Van Buren Township Hall on Tyler & Quirk road.
- Games will be played on Saturdays, with some mid week games, depending on the amount of teams playing in each age group.
- U9-U19 play all home games at Quirk Park and away games no more than 30-40 minutes away.

Adult Co-Ed League

The VBSA has started a new co-ed adult soccer league for anyone 18 or older.

The games are 8v8 on a smaller field, with unlimited substitutions, where 2 females must be on the field at all times. This is a great way to get out and get some exercise, in a fun way.

All games are played at Quirk Park on Sunday afternoons, starting around 4:00pm-6:00pm, games will start the week after Easter.
